75th Legislative Session Underway

The 2009 legislature is in session in Salem. CCB, with approval of the Governor's office, has submitted five bills this session. Three of these bills are intended to help contractors by:

- Streamlining residential notice requirements;
- Eliminating duplication in contracts; and
- Protecting contractor's personal identifying information.

The other two bills will help clarify existing law.

These bills first go to the state senate. Each bill is identified by "Senate Bill" (or "SB") and a corresponding number. If the state senate passes the bill (with or without amendments) it goes to the House. If the House passes the bill (with or without amendments) it goes to the floor of both the House and Senate for a vote.

The following is a summary of the content of the bills.

SB 202 clarifies law. SB 202 moves cleaning or servicing chimneys from the overall definition of "contractor" to the list of persons who are contractors. The change has no effect chimney sweeps. SB 202 also removes the reference to the total cost of contracts from the definition of "general contractor." SB 202 defines "general

contractor" by work performed rather than the cost of the project.

SB 203 makes Oregon's consumer lien notice requirement consistent with other CCB's laws. CCB's laws require a written contract for construction of \$2,000 or more. The lien law requires a notice about construction liens for construction of \$1,000 or more. SB 203 would establish a \$2,000 threshold for lien notices. This would make the threshold the same as for the written contract. SB 203 also makes some "housekeeping" changes for terms used in the lien statute.

SB 204 clarifies law. SB 204 explicitly provides that residential bonds will pay complaints against residential contractors. Commercial bonds will pay complaints against commercial contractors.

Governor's Safety & Health (GOSH) Conference

If you read the headlines, then you know 2007 was a dangerous year for construction in Oregon. Twelve people in the construction industry died on the job, with falls being the leading cause of accidents that year. If you are wondering how to make safety a reality in your workplace, consider attending the Oregon Governor's Occupational Safety and Health (GOSH) Conference (www.oregongosh.com) on March 9-12, 2009 at the Oregon Convention Center in Portland.

In these days of tight budgets, it can be tempting to set aside concerns about health and safety in the workplace. But that's a short-sighted decision, given the real risks of workplace injury and illness – especially for those working

in construction. The GOSH Conference promises to be a good value for those who take the time to attend.

Construction employers can improve their understanding of safety issues related to portable cranes, scaffolding, electrical hot work, excavations, confined spaces, ladders, chemical exposures, material handling, and more. Responsibility of construction foremen, reducing injuries to young workers, teaching safety to a multicultural workforce, and questions of legal liability are some of the topics covered this year.

Construction managers can attend training sessions on pre-construction planning and addressing issues of sustainability and lean construction. There are opportunities to learn about the intersection of worker protection and public protection on construction sites. You can also get advice about the use of construction charters to identify and control worksite hazards.

The GOSH Conference is one of the best safety training values in the country – and it's available right here in Oregon. Not only can it help you fulfill your obligation to provide a safe workplace for your employees, but it also can help you turn that obligation into a competitive edge during tough economic times. Safety pays. On January 2009, Oregon employers as a whole will start their 19th year with stable or declining workers' compensation premium rates – but individual employers also have learned that they can use their experience to give them an advantage when they bid jobs. And the benefits of an investment in safety show up in higher morale, reduced retraining costs, and better retention of your most skilled employees.

If you have been to GOSH in the past, you know it will be time well spent. If you and your workers have never seized this opportunity, the time has come. I look forward to seeing you!

Continuing Education: CCE - RCE Update

Continuing education requirements were made part of Oregon law during the 2007 Legislative session. The CCB spent the past year researching continuing education in other states, listening to contractors and stakeholders, and working to tackle the issues brought forth by the Construction Claims Task Force.

To begin such a big task, the CCB divided the continuing education into two programs: Commercial Continuing Education (CCE) and Residential Continuing Education (RCE). CCE is established and contractors that are commercially endorsed should be taking continuing education. The RCE is still being developed. The following is information on both programs.

Commercial Contractors

As of July 1, 2008 newly licensed contractors or contractors that renewed with a commercial endorsement are subject to the commercial continuing education requirements. They must complete the required CCE hours before their next renewal.

Contractors that are still licensed under the category system, and plan to get a commercial endorsement, will be subject to the CCE requirements after

they renew their license and choose the commercial endorsement. They will have the two-year licensing period to take the qualifying CCE.

Residential Contractors

Continuing education for contractors that have or will have a residential endorsement is getting closer to completion.

Committee members and CCB staff have been meeting for several months discussing the mandates in ORS 701.126, the elements of a program that would make sense for businesses and help consumers and the logistics of implementing such a program.

Information on all the continuing education meetings is available on the CCB website under Stakeholder Meetings. The residential continuing education program remains pending and will have final recommendation, discussion and approval by the Board.

Installing Propane Equipment Requires OSFM License

The Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) recently became aware of a contractor performing propane equipment and piping work in Oregon without appropriate licenses required by the OSFM.

The contractor was unaware of the OSFM requirements regarding propane equipment installation.

The OSFM reminds contractors who install or work on propane equipment of the necessity of holding the appropriate licenses.

Contractors can find the OSFM licensing requirements in the "box notes" in their current fuel gas sections of Oregon Residential Specialty Code & Oregon Mechanical Specialty Code. Contractors installing propane equipment under these codes should be aware of OSFM licensing requirements.

OR- OSHA: Changes to Safety Committee Rules

Rule change provides more flexibility

A key Oregon Occupational Safety and Health Division (Oregon OSHA) rule has been revised to provide greater clarity and flexibility to employers seeking to involve their workers in discussions of health and safety on the job.

The rule requires all employers to have a safety committee or hold safety meetings with their employees. Previously, a stricter set of safety committee requirements applied to employers with more than 10 employees. Smaller employers also had to have a safety committee, regardless of size, if they were in a high-risk industry (such as construction) or if they had a high rate of claims requiring time off work, compared to their industry as a whole.

“Almost all construction employers had to have a safety committee, even if they had only one part-time employee,” said Michael Wood, administrator of Oregon OSHA. “And

the rule didn’t allow employers to comply using on-site “all hands” meetings – which many of those in the construction industry have told us work better than a monthly or quarterly meeting—.”

Under the new rules, all employers will need either to have a safety committee or to use the less formal option of safety meetings to involve their employees in addressing jobsite safety. Construction employers will have the option of using safety meetings. Even large construction companies can choose to rely upon the safety meeting model.

According to the Oregon Employment Department, small businesses employing 10 or fewer employees represent 80 percent of the state’s employers.

“In order to effectively prevent injury and illness on the job, you need meaningful involvement by employees,” Wood said. “The rules

before were confusing for small employers. This change not only provides greater clarity and increases flexibility, we also believe it will promote more conversation about health and safety issues on the job. That has always been the purpose of the safety committee requirement.”

The new rule takes effect on Jan. 1, 2009, for large employers and employers in the construction industry. The rule change also eliminates the mandatory penalty of at least \$100 for not having a safety committee.

Submitting Court Judgements to CCB

A previous CCB newsletter made contractors aware of a law about reporting court judgments that went into effect this past year.

The article explained that beginning January 1, 2008, Oregon law requires contractors to send the Board a copy of unpaid court judgments ordering the contractor to pay damages relating to construction or proposed construction (ORS 701.109). This requirement applies if the damages are for:

- Breach of contract
- Negligent work or
- Improper work

The requirement includes court judgments and court orders upholding arbitration awards.

You must send CCB a copy of the judgment within 45 days after it is recorded, unless you pay the judgment within 30 days or have properly appealed the judgment.

In addition to accepting the copy of the court judgment by mail, the agency has developed an online solution through CCB “My License” to deliver the copy of the court judgment. Visit www.oregon.gov/CCB. Click on CCB “My License” to access.

Contractors planning to mail the copy of the court judgment should download or call for the required accompanying form. The form can be found under Contractor Forms/ Miscellaneous Forms.

SB 205 eliminates duplication of required notices information. Written contracts must contain summaries of CCB's notices. However, contractors are required to provide consumers a copy of the actual notices. Contracts must refer to a maintenance schedule when constructing new residential structures, however, contractors are required to provide the actual maintenance schedules. SB 205 streamlines the law and eliminates duplication.

SB 206 protects contractor's personal identification. A contractor obtaining or renewing a license must provide personal identification, including a birth date and a driver's license number. SB 206 would make that information confidential. SB 206 also excludes large, SEC-registered companies from providing such information.

Glossary of Legislative Terms

Amendment: An alteration made or proposed to be made to a measure. Measures may be amended more than once.

Bill: A measure that creates a new law, amends or repeals and existing law, appropriates money, prescribes fees or takes other action.

Do Pass: The recommendation by a committee for passage, abbreviated as DP. DPA means "do pass with amendments".

Drop: Refers to submitting a committee report to the appropriate desk.

Effective Date: ORS 171.022 reads that except as otherwise provided in an Act, an Act of the Legislative Assembly takes effect January 1 of the year after the passage of the Act.

Engrossed Bill: A measure that is printed with its amendments included. It will have "A" (or B, or C, etc.) Engrossed at the top which signals that the bill has changed from its original form.

Enrolled Bill: The final copy of the bill which has passed both houses of Legislature and has been specially reprinted for the signatures of President of the Senate and Speaker of the House. After these confirmatory signatures, the enrolled bill goes to the Governor.


Readings: The recitation of the measure's number, title and sponsor. The First reading the measure is referred to a committee by the Speaker or the President. The Second reading occurs after the measure has been referred to the committee, worked on and reported back to the floor of the house it originated in for a vote. The Third reading occurs on the floor by either house usually before the final vote.

Civil Penalties Issued October 01, 2008 - December 31, 2008

The Oregon Construction Contractors Board (CCB) recently announced final orders assessing civil penalties issued to Oregon contractors for violation of the Construction Contractors Law (ORS 701). Oregon law requires all construction contractors to be licensed with the CCB before they advertise, bid on, or perform construction, remodeling, or repair work.

The CCB issued 589 penalties between October 1, 2008 and December 31, 2008. Contractors receiving penalties include the following: (See Violations Key at the end of the list for violation and description).

DEQ's Heating Oil Tank Program

Prior to conducting an excavation or redevelopment of a property or residence, please check the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality's Facility Profiler website for information regarding suspected or known environmental contamination:

After typing in the site address, be sure to click on the “View Facility/Site List” hyperlink on the upper left hand corner of the website to get a detailed list of facilities that may match your site address.

If a site has been issued a closure letter for the decommissioning, assessment, and certification of a heating oil tank (HOT), contamination may still be present on the property.

If you plan to conduct work on a site where a HOT was or is present, and you are unsure of the levels of contamination remaining at the property, please contact the Department's HOT Program at:

503-667-8414 extension 55026

Depending on the levels of contamination present and the site conditions, a DEQ licensed HOT service provider may be required to provide oversight of project activities. Also, please remember that all decommissioning, assessment, and cleanup (including soil removal) for underground HOTs **must** be conducted by a DEQ licensed HOT Service Provider.

License Endorsements: A Few Frequently Asked Questions

How do I know which endorsement to choose?

Choose your endorsement based on the type of structures you will be working on. A contractor with a residential endorsement can work on residential and small commercial structure types; a contractor with a commercial endorsement can work on large and small commercial structure types. A chart explaining these three structures types is available on the CCB website.

Will I pay more for endorsements?

No. Contractors only pay the non-refundable application fee for their license.

When do I have to choose an endorsement?

Endorsements became part of CCB law July 1, 2008. At that time all new licensees began choosing an endorsement. Beginning July 1, 2008, when a contractor receives their renewal form, they also must choose an endorsement for their license. All contractors will be phased in to new endorsement system by July 1, 2010.
