Discussion/interpretation: The Former Foster Care Youth Medical (FFCYM) Program is transferring from Branch 5508 (Children’s Medical Unit) to OHP Customer Service on December 1, 2015. The new Oregon Eligibility (ONE) System includes eligibility determinations for the Former Foster Care Youth Medical program. Effective with the ONE system implementation on December 1, 2015, the initial eligibility determination and follow-up case maintenance for FFCYM will become the responsibility of OHP Customer Service. The Oregon Administrative Rules for the FFCYM Program will transition from CW Title XIX Medicaid rules to OHP Health System rules. The new rule will be 410-200-0407.

Implementation/transition instructions: All communications related to former foster care youth go to OHP Customer Service at 1-800-699-9075, or sent to the OHP medical eligibility mail box at OHPCW.Requests@dhsoha.state.or.us

Training/communication plan: The Federal Revenue Specialists were trained on the new referral procedure October 22, 2015. ILP Partners received training on October 27, 2015. The OHP Customer Service eligibility staff are also receiving training.

Local/branch action required: Federal Revenue Specialists and Caseworkers will refer foster care children age 18 and older, who are leaving Child Welfare custody, to OHP Customer Service to apply for FFCYM benefits. All DHS and OHA staff who assist young adults age 18 and up to age 26 will refer former foster care youth to OHP Customer Service.
