## Procuring the Independent Reviewer

On Dec. 2, 2015 the Department of Administrative Services procurement office posted a contracting opportunity. DAS is seeking a contractor to perform an independent review and assessment of the Department of Human Services (DHS) child foster care system. The contracting opportunity posted described the reasons an independent review is necessary and instructions on how potential contractors can submit a proposal for review.

Per Oregon Revised Statute 279B.060, the Opportunity Notice was published on the Oregon Procurement Information Network (ORPIN). It was also distributed to the following twelve firms:

A review committee has been assigned. The review committee includes people from DHS, DAS, and the Governor's Office. The selection processes will be guided by a "best value analysis." In general, the review committee will evaluate proposals based on the following criteria:

- a) Demonstrated skill and experience relevant to the project
- b) Demonstrated experience in public health and human services
- c) Proposed approach to the Project and Services
- d) Past performance
- e) Availability
- f) Price

To make an informed decision, it may be necessary to conduct supplemental evaluations. For this reason, the committee may reach out to entities that have submitted proposals to gather additional information and discuss specifics of a proposal. If this should occur, the DAS procurement office will amend the contracting opportunity posted to include these additional next steps.
