Compliance Tips

Admitting a Resident



New admit: OAR 411-54-0034 (250, 252, 255, 260, 303)

- Prescreen the resident to determine if facility is able to meet the resident's needs. This must be done prior to admit;
- Complete the Move- in Evaluation prior to move in, and first 30 days afterwards. If unable to complete move-in evaluation prior to move-in it must be done within 8 hours upon admission;
- The evaluation must include the list of the 13 elements 411-54-0034 (5a-m).
- The service plan must be completed upon admit and updated within the first 30 days of move-in; and
- The facility must ensure they have current physician's orders prior to admission, and the resident has their medications and treatments upon admit.

Re-admit: OAR 411-54-0034 (250, 252, 255, 260, 270, 280, 303)

- If the resident is re-admitted from the hospital, rehab, or a skilled setting, and had a change of condition, the RN must complete an assessment of that change of condition.
- If there was no change of condition then there should be an evaluation of why the resident went to the hospital including any follow up care;
- The service plan must be updated to reflect changes in the resident's needs;
- The facility must follow new MD orders and follow up care, or clarify new orders with the resident's PCP if the orders do not match.

Admit from adjacent ALF, RCF or MCC (250, 252, 255, 260, 270, 303)

- If the facility has an adjacent facility with a separate license, the facility must complete the process for new admits.
