Ms. Mason moved and Dr. Magnuson seconded that the minutes of the April 15, 2011 Board meeting be approved as amended. The motion passed with Dr. Smith, Dr. Huddleston, Ms. Mason, Dr. Magnuson, Dr. Hongo, Dr. Schwindt and Mr. Harvey voting aye.

**Oregon Dental Association**

## **COMMITTEE AND LIAISON REPORTS**

### **Dental Hygiene Committee Meeting Report**

Ms. Mason stated that the Dental Hygiene Committee met April 15 directly after the Board meeting to discuss a few changes to the Dental Practice Act. All of the changes that were recommended to the Board were housekeeping changes.

Ms. Mason stated that the first rule discussed was OAR 818-035. The Committee voted to recommend the Board amend and adopt 818-035-0025 as follows: add (9) Place or remove healing caps and healing abutments and (10) Place implant impression copings to make it consistent with what had been done earlier with the dental assisting prohibitions.

Ms. Mason stated that the second item was OAR 818-001-0002 and the Committee recommends they adopt changes as follows: Under Definitions in Division 1 there were changes from ORS 680.170 to 680.205 that had never been updated. She added that there was a second part to 818-001-0002(10), which was the definition of Limited Access Patient as the definition had been changed in the past but it was missed in this particular section. This would be maintaining the definition throughout the Dental Practice Act.

Ms. Mason stated that the final rule discussed was OAR 818-021-0025, Application for License to Practice Dental Hygiene Without Further Examination. That change was to 818-021-0001(c) and adds the word clinical to make it congruent with dental.

Ms. Mason moved and Dr. Magnuson seconded to send these recommendations to the Rules Committee. The motion passed with Dr. Smith, Dr. Huddleston, Ms. Mason, Dr. Magnuson, Dr. Hongo, Dr. Schwindt and Mr. Harvey voting aye.

### **WREB Liaison Report**

Dr. Huddleston stated that he went to his first WREB Operative Committee meeting and he found it very informative. He added that the Committee will be meeting again in August.

Dr. Magnuson stated the he was glad we had another representative on such an important WREB committee and thanked Dr. Huddleston for doing that work. Dr. Magnuson reminded the Board that WREB is switching to a different governance system and that they had just finished reviewing the list of people running for the Board of Directors next year, which will be voted on in July, in Park City, Utah. Dr. Magnuson added that he had been assigned as Chair for the Dental Exam Review Board, which also gets him a seat on the Board of Directors automatically. Dr. Magnuson stated that he will not be attending the Western Conference of Dental Examiners and Dental School Deans, which usually follows the WREB Board Meeting, as he is not happy with their agenda for the year. He stated that they have Dr. Tucker from Washington speaking on why we should have gold in dental schools for all four sessions, and he felt that it was too much focus on one specific subject. He stated that he would be talking to the President and the Executive Director of the Western Conference regarding this subject.

### **AADB Liaison Report**

Ms. Mason said there was nothing to report currently for AADB and that the next meeting will be held in October.

### **ADEX Liaison Report**

Dr. Parker and Mr. Braatz were not available to provide an ADEX update.

### **NERB**

Dr. Hongo stated that the NERB Steering Committee meeting will be held at the end of June and a full report would be available at the August Board meeting.

### **Oregon Prescription Drug Summit**

Dr. Huddleston attended the Oregon Prescription Drug Summit and stated it was very informative. He stated that prescription abuse seems to be a more accepted form of drug abuse for 18-35 year olds. There is an emphasis on trying to get the public to become more aware of the problem, getting practitioners to cut down prescribing too many pills and to educate the public on what should be done with leftover medication. ## **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

### **Budget Status Report**

Mr. Braatz attached the latest budget reports for the 2009-2011 Biennium to review in his absence. The reports show revenue of \$2,027,177.68 and expenditures of \$1,911,257.12 and are performing as expected.

### **New Board Member**

Mr. Smyth introduced the Board's newest member, Julie Ann Smith, D.D.S., M.D. Dr. Smith stated that she is currently an OHSU faculty member in the Oral Surgery Department and has been with OHSU since 2008. Prior to OHSU, Dr. Smith was on active duty in the Army at Walter Reed Army Medical Center for seven years. Dr. Smith added that she was excited about being an advocate for the citizens of Oregon. Dr. Smith was confirmed by the Oregon State Senate in May.

### **Customer Service Survey Report**

Mr. Braatz attached a chart which showed the OBD State Legislatively Mandated Customer Service Survey Results from July 1, 2010 through May 31, 2011. The results of the survey show that the OBD continues to receive positive comments from the majority of those that return the surveys. The booklet containing the written comments that are on the survey forms, which staff has reviewed, are available on the table for Board members to review.

### **2011-2013 OBD Budget**

The OBD Governor's Recommended Budget in the amount of \$2,509,517.00 passed the Oregon House on a vote of 46 -12 and the Oregon Senate on a vote of 22 – 7, and is awaiting the Governor's signature.

Mr. Braatz asked the Board to authorize his attendance at the American Association of Dental Administrators (AADA) Meeting on October 11-12, 2011 and the American Association of Dental Boards (AADB) Meeting on October 9-10, 2011, in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Dr. Hongo moved and Dr. Schwindt seconded that the Board approve Mr. Braatz's attendance at the AADB and AADA meetings. The motion passed with Dr. Smith, Dr. Huddleston, Ms. Mason, Dr. Magnuson, Dr. Hongo, Dr. Schwindt and Mr. Harvey voting aye.

It was also noted that Senior Assistant Attorney General Lori Lindley will be attending the Board Attorneys' Roundtable Meeting held in conjunction with the AADB Meeting and Dr. Patricia Parker and Jill Mason, M.P.H., R.D.H., who are the Dental and Dental Hygiene liaisons, will be authorized to attend the AADB meeting as well.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

#### **The Board received a letter from David Howerton, D.M.D.**

Dr. Howerton is asking for clarification whether an anesthesia monitor with a current healthcare provider CPR card is allowed to turn Nitrous Oxide off and turn on 100% oxygen, if the doctor has stepped out of the room and the patient has begun to develop adverse reactions.

It was the Board’s decision that there is no rule prohibiting assistants from turning off Nitrous Oxide, but they are not allowed to adjust the Nitrous Oxide. The Board directed Mr. Braatz to respond to Dr. Howerton as such.

#### **The Board received a letter from Brian Kennedy, ADA Chair, Council of Dental Education**

Mr. Kennedy sent a letter to all presidents and directors of dental societies and Boards regarding specialty licensure.

#### **The Board received a letter from Raymond Gist, D.D.S. - ADA President**

Dr. Gist sent a letter regarding ADA resolution 106H-2010, which states that the ADA strongly encourages testing agencies to examine candidates for dental licensure separately from candidates for allied dental licensure.
