History

CAMP helps under-represented students successfully complete their first year of college and graduate.

Serving **close to 385 participants** since 2004, Oregon State University CAMP is among the nation's **most successful CAMP programs**.

Grant funded by the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Migrant Education through 2019.

Retention/Outreach

- **Migrant/seasonal farmworker families**
- Recruit 35 Students each year, 175 students over 5 years
- Target Area: throughout the state of Oregon
- Primarily Hispanic, low income, rural, first generation with high financial need and academic need

Support First-Year

- Academic, personal, and financial support
- Orientation, advising, and counseling
- Tutoring and mentoring
- Technology support (laptops, iPads, calculators)
- Follow-up support, monitoring, referrals
- Assistance obtaining aid and scholarships

Success (2014-2015)

- **GPRA I – 93%** of participants **completed their first year of study successfully** with 36 credits or more, surpassing the goal of 86%.
- **GPRA II – 97.6%** of successful students **persisted in college in Fall 2015**, surpassing the goal of 85%.
- **Graduation – 66%** of the 2009-2010 CAMP cohort **graduated** with Bachelors degrees.
