Descriptive, objective criteria for liberal education; a reinvigoration of liberal learning for C21 – assessment
- 3. VALUE Rubric:** method of assessment that relies on observable performance indicators – assessment
- 4. Degree Qualifications Profile:** a set of common qualitative descriptors of students prepared for work and civic life – assessment, transfer, employment
- 5. Quality Collaboratives:**  
Assessment, faculty development, best practices for implementing DQP—assessment, transfer, faculty, curriculum redesign
- 6. Passport [WICHE]:** a learning outcomes based approach to inter- and intrastate lower division transfer agreements --transfer, faculty
- 7. Compass [CSU, OUS, WI]**  
High Impact Practices geared for underserved students – student success
- 8. Multistate Collaborative [SHEEO]:**  
a multistate database of work-products for applying the VALUE rubric – assessment, student success
- 9. Faculty Collaboratives**  
A culminating or “capstone” effort to integrate the various components of LEAP in key states through faculty development funding and creation of “innovation hubs.”
