RE: TSPAC Recreation Subcommittee Meeting Report 5/23/12

The first meeting of the TSPAC Recreation Subcommittee was attended in person by committee members Laurel Hillmann and DLCD staff member Andy Lanier. Jason Busch and Charlie Plybon, acting as elected alternate to Gus Gates, attended online. Chris Chandler was not present. The meeting was recorded and a digital audio file will be available from the department.

The meeting focused primarily on a review and of the draft plan recommendation to apply a recreational overlay along with the screening criteria that would be applied for determining if a proposed development would have an adverse impact on activities or resources within the overlay zone. Jason Busch questioned the need for the overlay zone, or the application of any zones in general, and asserted that an alternative process for addressing the potential adverse impacts of a specific proposed development on recreational uses or any other resource, would be to rely on the existing regulatory review process and the available data. The group decided that this question was not pertinent to the work of the subcommittee and would more properly be addressed by the full TSPAC or LCDC. It was agreed that the subcommittee would affirm the concept of the marine recreation overlay and the criteria as described in the draft plan framework with no additional changes.
