2 In the case of Housing Commission vs. Forest Grove, _ Or
3 LUBA ____ (LUBA No. 82-101, Slip Op 09/28/83), the Board
4 reversed an amendment to the charter of the City of Forest
5 Grove. Because of that reversal, the city undertook to repeal
6 Ordinance No. 83-5, the city ordinance implementing the
7 provisions of the charter amendment. On January 9, 1984, the
8 city council repealed Ordinance No. 83-5. The repealing
9 ordinance contains an emergency clause and is therefore
10 effective immediately.

11 Because the subject of this appeal, Ordinance 83-5 has been
12 repealed, this proceeding is dismissed.
