

\$1566.00; and Licensees owed these amounts since at least April 10, 2010, and was therefore more than ninety (90) days past due.

6. Licensees, therefore, violated OAR 830-030-0000(7) which is cause for disciplinary action under ORS 692.180(1)(g).

WHEREAS, the Board and the Licensees are desirous of resolving and settling those matters regarding Case Nos. 10-1039A and 10-1039B without further proceedings thereon; and

WHEREAS, Licensees are aware of the right to a hearing with the assistance of counsel and the right to judicial review of the Board's decision in Case Nos. 10-1039A and 10-1039B and hereby freely and voluntarily waives those rights; and

WHEREAS, Licensees hereby acknowledges that Licensees have read, understands, and agrees to the terms of this Consent Order and that this Consent Order constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and is a final order of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Licensees agree that the Board enter the following order:

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Licensees are reprimanded for violation of OAR 830-030-0000(7) and ORS 692.180(1)(g).
2. This Consent Order shall become effective when signed by the Executive Director
