Subject: Notes from Nov 11 Rules meeting

Present : Lisa, Chris, Michael, Patty, Shel and Diana

We looked through the Statute again as that is the document most important to get to Board by January. I'm going to try and combine the notes from the Sept 8 meeting and this one.

687.011 Definitions

2) "Certified class" or "certified program" means a class or program that is approved...

5) "Massage and bodywork" means manual therapies that involve touch on the body for the purpose of but not limited to promoting physical and emotional well-being using soft tissue manipulation, movement integration, structural integration and energy balancing using but not limited to:

a) use of pressure, wrapping, friction, stroking, tapping, kneading, or stretching;

b) use of appliances;

c) use of topical preparations.

[Patty and Shel will clean this up. We found 2 instances in the Rules where "massage" was used alone and two instances in Statute where "massage and bodywork" were used to together. We think combining them will work. It is important, however, that we remember this is a housekeeping bill so we don't want to get to far out there.]

687.021. Practice of massage without active license prohibited

687.021. (1) No person shall engage in or purport to be in the practice of massage without an active massage therapist license.

687.031 Patty will rewrite into 2 Statutes - one for exceptions (old 687.031 (1)) and one for temporary license old 687.031 (2)). Use Jill's change "for the purpose of" to "in the sole performance of". Change "30 days" to 30 consecutive days. Possibly use the following suggestions in the re-write:

-687.031 (1) (b), (c), (d) - DELETE

687.041 - No changes

687.051 - Omit "after January 1, 1999"

(d) Have completed a minimum of 500 contact ours of certified classes/programs in the following...

(e) Pass an examination(s) prepared.... The examination(s) shall be

687.057 Change "indorsement" to "endorsement" through out. We felt no other changes were needed to this statute,

687.061 Already redone

687.071 Already redone

687.075 - 687.991 No changes

Regarding OARs -

Everyone should look at 334-010-0025 Practice of Massage. We don't want this to be just a repetition of the definition. It should contain more specific material, for example, spelling out the appliances or topical preparations.

Next meeting - Dec 8 from 9am-12 (if necessary). Shel will prepare a DRAFT ORS 687 with our changes bolded or struck through for us to give the final look over. This will then go to Board members ahead of time for their January 12th meeting review. If we can we will also continue reviewing the OARs.
