Legislative Discussion: Legislative Concept 796 is in final draft version; it is posted on the Board's Web site under **Laws, Rules & Policies**.

Modality Endorsements: The committee reviewed the parameters for endorsements. Suggestions were made for parameters to include the hours of training, endorsement categories, overarching organizations, and anatomy/physiology. **Grossart:** I would like to see the endorsements categories be separate professions or large enough they have an organization, also Anatomy/Physiology specific techniques. A discussion ensued surrounding the levels of training and requirements of endorsements. Is there a set amount of hours the committee can list for each of category or for endorsements in general? The Committee can propose to the Board that when individuals come forward to request endorsement, the endorsement be sent to the Scope Committee to review.

The committee agreed that a **Structural Integrator Endorsement** should require: *Completion of a SI program that consisted of 500 hours of theory and practicum.*

The committee drafted suggested parameters for license endorsements.


