Opening on the Oregon Board of Tax Practitioners

Two tax practitioner positions will be open this spring on the Oregon Board of Tax Practitioners. Dorothy Hudson LTC, EA (Klamath Falls) has served on the Board since 2008; and Janis Salisbury LTC, EA, past Board chair (Oregon City) has also served since 2008.

Applicants must be an actively practicing tax consultant for at least five years. Women, people of color, and bilingual persons are encouraged to apply (SB 786). Applicants from Southern and Eastern Oregon are encouraged to apply so that those areas of the state have representation.

A tax consultant wishing to be considered should submit the Interest Form directly to the Governor's Executive Appointment's office. Board members serve a three year term, and two terms is the usual limit. A member serves at the pleasure of the Governor. Once appointed by the Governor, a Board member is subject to confirmation by the Senate.

The Board of Tax Practitioners meets bimonthly excluding tax season (January, May, July, September, and November) to consider licensing, examination, discipline, and practice issues affecting personal income tax preparation in Oregon. Board members review executive session issues and complaints at each meeting. Board members also participate in outreach to tax practitioners and other stakeholders at meetings around the state. The Board helps Oregonians feel confident that they receive accurate tax advice and prompt filing of their personal returns by encouraging professional responsibility of its licensees and providing assistance on compliance issues.
