Linn Benton: Note-Additional 330 hrs in ED104, not required.

Clackamas: Current on-site child dev. center will become lab school once NAEYC accreditation is obtained.

OSU-Cascades Campus: 9: Practicum Other-one of the above practicums is a 12 credit practicum, total of 360 hours (330 onsite, 10 journaling and 20 seminar)

10: #4 one practicum is research based, the other two focused on curriculum, individualizing and families

11: these are upper division practicum experiences required by our Human Dev, & Family Sciences

PCC: 7: depending on placement, may be portion of advanced experience.

MCHH: Note-Trying to distinguish "required" components from "choices" is a comparison that makes little sense in our program.

By the very nature of our population in the college child development center, all students gain experience with Head Start families,(for example) but we don't require that students specifically spend time with those specific children in order to get the degree.

SOCC: 8: For second year or distance learners.

Note- Our AAS degree has 21 credits of Practicum & Student Teaching ECE 209 & ECE 102, ECE 163, ECE 261, ECE 262

Our distance students must find a practicum site where their onsite supervising classroom teacher meets the standards for CDA Advisors - see website for Council on Professional Development. Distance students are required to send video tapes of their work to the course instructor.

**Each of the following ECE 209, 102, 163 require one hour weekly of seminar with the course instructor and 6 hours weekly in the children's classroom. ECE 261 & ECE 262 requires 2 hours weekly of seminar time and 10 hours per week in the children's classroom.

**Our AS degree has 6 credits of Practicum ECE 209 ECE 102 and ED 280 3 credits of Internship/Work Experience

ED 280 requires 90 hours of onsite work, journaling and a final learning statement for the required 3 credits.
