

McFarland Livestock, LLC Animal Waste Management Plan Summary:

McFarland Livestock, LLC has proposed permitting for a Large Concentrated feedlot CAFO based on 1,400 permitted cattle with a herd composition of 1,400 mixed breed calves. The feedlot is operated by Dan McFarland.

McFarland Livestock, LLC operates a seasonal feedlot facility that may reach up to 1,400 mixed breed calves that are confined in open lots from November to April. Runoff from the open lots flows to a vegetated treatment area (VTA). If a large storm event causes ponding in the VTA, the operator will pump and export the excess feedlot runoff water to neighboring farmland. McFarland Livestock, LLC has approximately 119 acres just southeast of Klamath Falls available for manure application. This acreage is located to the northeast of where Short Rd intersects with Hwy 39; said intersection is approximately 0.5 miles south of the intersection of Southside Hwy 140 and Hwy 39. Excess manure is removed from the pens and applied at or below agronomic application rates listed in the Animal Waste Management Plan (AWMP). Fresh water irrigation is applied at rates to meet the crop needs but also to prevent runoff or nutrient leaching from occurring.

All conservation practices installed will be managed and maintained in accordance with the Conservation Practice Operation and Maintenance Plan.
