Hello,

I am a homeowner in the Nedonna Beach area of Rockaway Beach, Oregon. I am very concerned about the quality of my drinking water and the apparent lack of concern by the City of Rockaway Beach officials and the two logging companies that regularly spray herbicides in our watershed.

Those of us working to protect drinking water on the north coast would like to see protections from clear-cut induced turbidity that resulted in Rockaway Beach's cancer-causing chemical alert in their water bills. Our drinking water also faces risks from herbicides, landslides, quarry operations, road run-off, etc.

**To increase the conservation value of state forest lands and provide full protections to our drinking watersheds, the Oregon Board of Forestry should facilitate land protections and transfers so that every drinking watershed comes into full conservancy.**
