

## **BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION FOR NEW NOMINEE TO EASTERN OREGON REGIONAL FOREST PRACTICE COMMITTEE**

### **Lon Casebeer**

Lon started in forestry with Weyerhaeuser in 1974 as a forest tech. His main duties were establishing plantations during the mid to late 70's. Other duties included burning of slash piles and windrows for plantation establishment, inventory update of harvested stands and plantation updates.

In the early 80's he moved into a forest protection position with Weyerhaeuser mainly dealing with fire control on the Weyerhaeuser Tree Farm and interfacing with outside agencies. After Weyerhaeuser sold to US Timberlands his duties were all of the above plus harvest unit layout and forest practices compliance. He was in this position for 5 years.

Then he worked for JWTR for 7 years as the East District Forester. Duties included, managing 250,000 acres east of Klamath Falls in all aspects of forestry, fire prevention and forest practices compliance.

Lon now works for Green Diamond Resources Company as the East District Forester, and has similar duties. He has been at the same desk for forty years with various companies doing a variation of duties during this time.
