


# 5 things to know about Oregon's Bridges







## 271 / 2,700

Of Oregon's 2,700 state highway bridges, 271 were repaired or replaced under the OTIA program at a cost of \$1.3 billion over 10 years.  
*That's only 10% of our bridges.*

Within 35 years, two-thirds of state bridges will have deferred rehabilitation needs.
