



5 things to know about Oregon's Bridges



Of Oregon's 2,700 state highway bridges, 271 were repaired or replaced under the OTIA program at a cost of \$1.3 billion over 10 years. *That's only 10% of our bridges.*

100,000 JOBS EXIT AHEAD

When bridges are closed to trucks, it means delays, higher costs and reduced job growth. *Oregon could lose 100,000 jobs by 2035 because of restricted bridges.*
