02840.60 – Pavement Markers, Type 2

Description - This category is for non-reflectORIZED markers to be mounted on the surface of asphalt or concrete surfaces. The markers shall be able to adhere to asphalt or concrete surfaces with bituminous or epoxy adhesives.

Process - Submit the following:

- Preliminary Information for Product Evaluation Form.
- Independent Test Results showing compliance with Specs listed below.
- Product Data Sheet.
- Detailed installation instructions.
- List of Limitations and Precautions.
- Submit 15 markers for our evaluation (each color).
- Submit evidence that product is currently on the Caltrans and WSDOT QPL.

Specifications - ODOT is currently preparing a specification for this category, but in the meantime we will allow any product that has been placed on both the Caltrans and Washington DOT Qualified Products List. Once we confirm placement on those lists, and assuming no other conflicts, your submittal will be routed to the next available QPL meeting. Continued placement on ODOT's QPL requires suitable performance in the field and continued existence on the Caltrans and Washington DOT Qualified Products List. Contacts for CALTRANS and WSDOT are:
