

I-5 Paving Project:

Marquam Bridge to Capitol Highway

Paving on I-5 Begins in 2015

Next summer, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is repaving approximately 7 miles of roadway on I-5 between the Marquam Bridge and Capitol Highway, including several freeway ramps. The pavement along this stretch of I-5 is deteriorating and in need of repair. An ODOT contractor will remove and replace old pavement to maintain a safe and smooth driving surface. The last time this section of I-5 was paved was in 2004. The project is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2015, but is weather dependent and subject to change.

Project Key Facts

- » Work also includes improvements on several bridges.
- » Paving and ramp closures will occur at night during the following hours:
 - » Sunday - Thursday: 8:00 p.m. - 5:30 a.m.
 - » Friday - Saturday: 8:00 p.m. - 9:00 a.m.
- » Multiple lane closures on I-5 will occur at night.
- » Daytime shoulder closures on I-5 may occur.
- » There will be several full nighttime closures of the northbound and southbound on-ramps to the Marquam Bridge. Only one direction will be closed at a time.
- » Paving in the far right lane of the freeway (in both directions) will require temporary on and off ramp closures within the active work area.

Ramp Paving & Repairs

The following on and off ramps will be **closed** while they are improved. Ramp closures will occur at night.

1. Harbor Way
2. Southbound and Northbound I-405 (at different times)
3. West Marquam
4. OR43 (SW Hood Ave.), to Lake Oswego
5. Corbett Ave.
6. Terwilliger Blvd.
7. Multnomah Blvd. to Terwilliger (Northbound I-5)
8. Spring Garden St.
9. Taylors Ferry Rd.
10. Capitol Highway




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All lanes will remain open during daytime

To reduce impacts to motorists, all lanes on I-5 will remain open during the day and construction will take place at night. Construction will occur between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. on weekdays and from 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. on the weekends. During nighttime work, both directions of I-5 may be reduced to one lane.



Bridge Improvements

Several bridges in the project area have deteriorating deck joints and concrete surfaces. Improvements will be done to address these needs on the following bridges:

- » Southbound Marquam Bridge (east and west ends)
- » SW Hood Ave. (OR43) overcrossing
- » SW Iowa St. Bridge (final paving and sealants only)
- » SW 26th Ave. overcrossing
