PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Design and construct improvements to Boones Ferry Road between Oakridge Rd/Reese Road and Madrona Street at the intersection of Lanewood Street and Boones Ferry Road. Work includes a median, bike lanes, sidewalk, landscaping, and other improvements and enhancements.

PURPOSE AND NEED

The Boones Ferry Road corridor from Madrona Street to Mercantile is an economic center in Lake Oswego with about 40 retail shops, 20 restaurants, 100 office/service businesses, an elementary school, and a post office. The project will provide improvements to roadway, pedestrian, and bicycle access in the corridor.

PROPOSED SOLUTIONS

- Full reconstruction of Boones Ferry Road from south of Madrona Street to north of Reese Road/Oakridge Road
- Construct crosswalk and pedestrian signal at the intersection of Lanewood Street and Boones Ferry Road
- Construct sidewalk, planter strips/tree wells, and install street lighting between Oakridge Road and Madrona Street
- Includes an inverted crown median with storm water treatment facility
- Construct left-turn lanes on some side streets

- Construct four to six foot retaining walls in some locations due to adjacent properties that are below grade
- Upgrade/install four signals and up to three pedestrian signals

ANTICIPATED BENEFITS

- Improve safety by providing separated sidewalks, bike lanes, and three new pedestrian crossings, including one at Lake Grove Elementary School
- Improve connectivity between the surrounding residential area with local commercial and government services
- Improve multimodal connectivity with the ability of pedestrians and bicyclists to use Boones Ferry to travel to Waluga Park and improving connectivity to bus route 37
- Promote active transportation modes by providing alternatives to motorized travel
