PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Design and construct sidewalks and bike connections in the Cully neighborhood of Portland

PURPOSE/NEED:

The Cully neighborhood was incorporated into Portland in 1985 with substandard transportation infrastructure. Cully is home to the single most diverse census tract in the State of Oregon. Today, only 34% of the streets in Cully have sidewalks, and the neighborhood has the second highest number of miles of unpaved streets in Portland. The lack of a dense grid requires out-of-direction travel deters walking and bicycling.

BENEFITS:

- Increases connectivity and access for people who walk, drive, bicycle, or use a mobility-device
- Improves safety by reducing speed on local streets via speed bumps and curb extensions
- Improves access to neighborhood schools, which serve as community centers
- Improves access to employers, businesses, as well as goods and services along Cully Boulevard and NE Killingsworth
- Improves the transportation safety and security for those who live and travel through Cully

ASSUMPTIONS:

GENERAL

- All cost over-runs are the responsibility of the applicant

NE KILLINGSWORTH AND PRESCOTT SIDE-WALK INFILL AND BUFFERED BIKE LANE

- Install 6-foot curb tight sidewalks
- Install 3-foot bike buffer on each bicycle lane
- Assume that extending sidewalks on Killingsworth from 39th to 42nd Avenue is not feasible
- Includes striping

NE 66TH AND 67TH AVENUE NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAYS

- Bike legends every 60-feet
- Remove NE 67th street parking and replace with bi-directional bike lanes

NE 54TH AND 55TH AVENUE NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAYS

- Install curb extensions
- Shared use path on 55th Avenue to be concrete sidewalk

NE 72ND AVENUE AND EMERSON

- Speed bumps at 300 foot spacing on NE Emerson and NE 72nd Avenue
- Pave a 12-foot wide path along NE 72nd Avenue from Emerson to Killingsworth

NE 60TH AVENUE AC PATH (PRESCOTT TO HWY 30)

- Pave a 8-foot wide path on NE 60th Avenue from NE Prescott to NE Portland Hwy
