



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Construct a one mile segment of the Historic Columbia River Highway State Trail between Summit Creek and Lindsey Creek in Hood River County.

PURPOSE AND NEED

The Summit Creek to Lindsey Creek Project is a 5.7 mile long integral piece of the Historic Columbia River Highway State Trail. Over 2,000 linear feet of the original 1914 pavement lays shrouded in a blanket of moss. The project will restore the original pavement and construct an additional 4,000 linear feet of trail to create a continuous 12-foot wide multi-use trail corridor between the Wyeth Trailhead (Lang State Park) and Viento State Park.

PROPOSED SOLUTIONS

- Restore 2000 linear feet of the Historic Highway in a trail
- Construct 4,000 feet of a new 12-foot wide multipurpose trail that will be ADA accessible
- Summit Creek Viaduct – This 800 foot long bridge like structure provides a ramp from the shoulder of I-84 to an intact section of historic pavement at an accessible grade

ANTICIPATED BENEFITS

- Provide a world class hiking and biking opportunity for all users through the Columbia River Gorge
- Contribute to the development of a seamless and multimodal transportation

system in the Columbia River Gorge, which includes shipping lanes on the river, Union Pacific Trains, an Interstate Highway for trucks and cars and a State Trail for cyclists, pedestrians and mobility impaired individuals

- Help achieve the Milepost 2016 Reconnection Strategy by the 100th anniversary of the Historic Highway construction
- Foster economic development by facilitating tourism through improved access to scenic views of the Columbia River
