





## REGIONAL/STATE TRAILS



**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Construct a 2.1 mile segment of the Historic Columbia River Highway (HCRH) State Trail between Wyeth (Interstate 84, Exit 51) and the Lindsey Creek State Scenic Corridor

**PURPOSE AND NEED**

The current shoulder width on I-84 as the freeway traverses Shellrock Mountain is less than four feet wide. With a speed limit of 65 miles per hour, accessing the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area (CRGNSA) in a mode other than a motor vehicle is dangerous and often too daunting to the average rider or hiker. The construction of this segment will help advance ongoing efforts to extend the Historic Highway State Trail through the Gorge.


**PROPOSED SOLUTIONS**

- Construct a 12-foot wide trail with 1 to 2 foot shoulders by constructing the trail behind the existing bin wall structure

- Ensure trail is ADA accessible
- Relocate the rockfall protection fence to ensure safety of the interstate and trail users
- Maintain visibility of historic rock walls from the 1910s

**ANTICIPATED BENEFITS**

- Contribute to the development of a seamless and properly separated multimodal transportation system in the Columbia River Gorge
- Provide safe access for cyclists and pedestrians around Shellrock Mountain
- Help to achieve the Milepost 2016 Reconnection Strategy by the 100th anniversary of the construction of the Historic Highway
- Foster economic development and facilitate tourism by improving access to world class hiking and biking opportunities through the Gorge with scenic views of the Columbia River
