



Sandy Boulevard at 105th Avenue Safety Project

The Oregon Department of Transportation is working to improve safety at the intersection of N.E. Sandy Boulevard (US 30 Bypass) and N.E. 105th Avenue, because of a history of vehicle crashes at this intersection. This project will create a separate turn lane and signal for motorists to safely turn left (south) from N.E. Sandy Boulevard onto N.E. 105th Avenue by removing a tree filled median.

Project benefits:

This project will benefit the community and motorists traveling on N.E. Sandy Boulevard:

Mobility/congestion relief: This project will allow motorists to safely turn southbound onto N.E. 105th Avenue and westbound onto N.E. Sandy Boulevard at new traffic signals.

Safety: The project will provide a new turn light and lane, as well as pedestrian countdown signal at N.E. Sandy Boulevard, to make travel safer for everyone.

When:

Construction is planned between June/July and September/October 2016, with most work taking place at night to reduce traffic impacts. *Schedule may change due to weather and site conditions.*


A 24-hour noise hotline will be available during construction for questions and concerns.
