



OREGON HIGHWAY 213 CASCADE HIGHWAY SOUTH @MULINO ROAD

PROJECT LOCATION

The project begins on Oregon Highway 213 in Mulino at the north end of the Milk Creek Bridge and ends just south of Passmore Road.

PROJECT SUMMARY

A safety and bridge project that includes:

- Replacing the Milk Creek Bridge
- Widening the highway for added shoulder width and to provide a continuous left-turn lane from Graves Road to the Mulino Road and Passmore Road intersections
- Installing curbs and sidewalks along the highway and Mulino Road
- Widening Mulino Road for separated left and right-turn lanes
- Realigning abrupt highway curves
- Installing a water quality swale in the northwest quadrant of the Freeman Road intersection
- Improving sight distance at the intersection of Graves Road and Highway 213

PURPOSE AND NEED

- The Milk Creek Bridge is aging (nearly 80 years old) and is in relatively poor condition.
- The Graves Road and Mulino Road intersections have had several accidents in the last few years with one fatality.
- There is significant congestion near the Mulino School and Passmore Road intersection at certain times of the day.

PROJECT TIMELINE

The contractor will begin construction in late January 2010. The project is estimated to be completed by June 2012.

CONSTRUCTION COST

Estimated \$5.4 million.

PROJECT IMPACTS

During weekday hours of 9:15 a.m. and 3:15 p.m., drivers can expect intermittent single lane closures with flaggers controlling traffic. Access to Highway 213 from Graves Road will be closed for certain durations of the project. Traffic will be directed to use Passmore Road as an alternative route to Highway 213. In addition, ODOT anticipates a significant amount of night work. ODOT will provide advance notice to nearby neighbors that will include 24-hour contact information in case issues arise.
