Tripcheck.com, cameras, down Wednesday

ODOT's TripCheck.com and camera network will be offline 10 a.m. to noon for repairs

ODOT's popular TripCheck.com web site and its network of highway cameras will be unavailable from 10 a.m. to noon Wednesday in the Portland area for repairs needed after a July 28 power outage in the Traffic Management Operations Center.

Crews will shut down power to install a new bypass switch to replace one damaged in the July outage. Crews will restore the system to full operations as soon as possible.

The shutdown will close TripCheck only in ODOT's Region 1 – eastern Washington County and all of Clackamas, Hood River and Multnomah counties – with no impact on TripCheck access elsewhere in the state.

TripCheck.com provides the public with real time information on traffic conditions around the state and makes available images from hundreds of cameras used by ODOT to monitor Oregon traffic.
