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TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Overnight I-5 north closures tonight

Motorists will use Exit 299A and the Macadam Avenue on-ramp to get around the closure

The contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation continues closures on Interstate 5 to work over the freeway on the Gibbs Street Pedestrian Bridge.

Tonight, March 28, from 11:30 p.m., to 5 a.m. Thursday, March 29, the contractor will close following:

- Interstate 5 northbound at the Oregon Highway 43/U.S. 26 Ross Island Bridge off-ramp (exit 299A).
- Interstate 405 northbound from I-5 northbound (exit 299B).
- I-405 northbound off-ramp to Naito Parkway (exit 1A).
- Starting at 8 p.m., the Southwest Harbor Drive on-ramp to I-5 southbound.

Detours:

- I-5 north: drivers will leave the freeway at Exit 299A and re-enter I-5 approximately 200 yards to the north using the Macadam Avenue on-ramp.
- I-405 northbound or U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway): drivers will take the I-5 detour, continue on I-5 northbound and take the Fremont Bridge to I-405 southbound.
- Motorists on Southwest Harbor Drive heading to I-5 southbound will follow a signed detour via SW Naito Parkway to the SW Hood Avenue on-ramp to access I-5.

Work above I-5 will continue throughout the week. ODOT will announce future closures for this work.
