OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES PLANNED FOR NORTHBOUND INTERSTATE BRIDGE

A series of overnight lane closures is scheduled for the northbound Interstate Bridge next week. Starting Sunday night, August 28 and continuing through Thursday night, Sept. 1 a single lane of northbound Interstate 5 will close at the bridge at 8:00 p.m. each night with a second northbound lane closing at 11:00 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5:30 a.m. each morning. During the overnight closure period, an Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) bridge crew will perform pavement repair work on or adjacent to the bridge. **At least one northbound lane of I-5 will remain open at all times.**

In order to safely complete this work, the Jantzen Beach on-ramp to northbound I-5 will close each night at 8:00 p.m. and will reopen by 5:30 a.m. each morning. During the overnight on-ramp closure period, drivers bound for I-5 north will take I-5 south to the Marine Drive off-ramp, exit the freeway and follow the detour signs back to I-5 north. The southbound lanes of I-5 will remain open at all times.

This work is weather dependent.
