### **Ross Island Bridge ramp to OR99E closed tonight**

*Bridge inspection will close the ramp from 8 p.m. to 2 a.m.*

**Starting tonight, Sept. 30, from 8 p.m. to 2 a.m. Thursday, Oct. 1,** Oregon Department of Transportation crews will close the eastbound **Ross Island Bridge (U.S. 26 Mt. Hood Highway) off-ramp to southbound Oregon Highway 99E (Pacific Highway East)**. The closure will allow crews to perform routine bridge inspections.

**Detour:**

Motorists traveling east on the Ross Island Bridge to Highway 99E will continue across the Ross Island Bridge, which becomes Powell Boulevard, then take the connecting ramp to S.E. 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continue south on S.E. 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. to Highway 99E.
