## US101: East Devil's Lake Road



### Project location

This project is located on US101 at the intersection of East Devil's Lake Road, north of Lincoln City.

### Project purpose

The purpose of this project is to reduce car wrecks at the intersection, mainly as a result of cars waiting to turn left on to East Devil's Lake and from East Devil's Lake on to US101.

### Project Description

The project will:

- Add a left turn lane for south bound traffic on US101 on to East Devil's Lake Road
- Improve sight distance for those who are turning, so they can see approaching traffic better.

### Why the project is needed

Thousands of cars, trucks, and motor homes move through this corridor on a daily basis. The congestion in the area is getting worse, and there have been a number of accidents at the intersection. These improvements will help traffic to move through the area in a safer manner.

### Current Status

The project is being designed and the plans should be completed by the end of 2015. Construction is expected to begin in summer of 2016, and should be completed by the end of the summer.

### Cost estimate

- The total estimated cost is \$2.68 million.
