
Project location

OR99W (W. 6th Avenue and W. 7th Avenue) between Roosevelt Boulevard and Garfield Street in Eugene

Project description

The Highway 99W pedestrian and bicycle improvement project is a collaborative effort between the City of Eugene and ODOT that will greatly enhance the pedestrian and bicycle environment along Highway 99 between Roosevelt Boulevard and Garfield Street. This section of Highway 99W currently has almost no sidewalks and is in a part of Eugene with little street connectivity.

Construction of a separated shared-use path from Roosevelt Boulevard to West 5th Avenue and additional sidewalks from West 5th Avenue to Garfield Street will improve connectivity, environmental sustainability, and pedestrian/bicycle access along Highway 99W, making this part of Eugene a more livable and walkable place for residents.

- Begin construction: Summer 2014
- End construction: Late 2014

Project cost and funding

- \$5.1 million for design and construction
- Funded by a Federal Flex Funds grant and the State Bicycle and Pedestrian Sidewalk Improvement Program
