US 101: Sea Lion Point Rock Wall Project Key #17696

Project location

- This wall rehabilitation project is in the vicinity of the Sea Lion Caves and located approximately 9 miles north of Florence on the Oregon Coast Highway 101.
- The projects outer limits are from mile point 166.48 to mile point 179.25.

Project background and need

- The original wall was constructed as a structural component of the highway circa 1931. Over time the wall has lost its integrity in several places and does not meet structural standards as a safety barrier or retaining wall.

Construction overview

- This project will restore the structural integrity and the aesthetic appearance of a portion of the historic rock wall along the ocean side of the highway. Construction will include rebuilding the wall sections with natural rock matching the appearance of the original wall and erecting interpretive signing.
- The project will also replace the bridge railing on a small half viaduct at mile point 166.48.
