Aug. 26 open house shares update on I-5 interchanges

Management plan focuses on Exits 124 and 125

ROSEBURG — The public is welcome to attend an Interchange Area Management Plan (IAMP) open house for Interstate 5 Exits 124 and 125. The IAMP is in its second year of a two-year study to provide specific transportation improvement projects for future consideration. The open house is scheduled from 4 to 7 p.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 26 at the Holiday Inn Express Hotel, 375 W. Harvard Ave.

"We want to hear from local business owners, property owners, residents, and commuters who use these interchanges regularly," said ODOT Senior Planner Tom Guevara. "The project alternatives we're going to share were developed from the input we received at last year's open house in September."

According to Guevara, the alternatives must meet several requirements, including a 20-year window to plan for the needs and growth around the Exit 124 (Harvard Avenue) and Exit 125 (Garden Valley Boulevard) interchanges.
