

Linn Road: OR 62 to Buchanan (E.P.)

Problem:

Linn Road is the main entrance into Eagle Point from Highway 62. It is also a major pedestrian route between businesses on either side of the highway, the nearby high school, youth center, senior center, City Hall/Police department, and community center.



The south side of Linn Road has narrow 5 foot sidewalks in some sections. There is no sidewalk on the north side. Existing bike lanes are not standard. Due to its high use, pedestrians and motorized scooters used by the disabled and elderly often use the bike lane or even the traffic lane. The existing narrow box culvert, with no sidewalk and narrow shoulders, forces bikes/peds

into the westbound traffic lane.

Project Scope:

The City of Eagle Point will design and construct bicycle and pedestrian improvements along Linn Road between Highway 62 and Buchanan Ave. Bike lanes would be widened to six feet in both directions - as needed on the south side. Curb, gutter and a six-foot wide sidewalk are proposed on the north side to facilitate additional pedestrian traffic, in addition to drainage improvements. The box culvert over Buchanan channel will be widened to accommodate bike/ped traffic. Pedestrian-scale lighting and a planted median would be added to beautify this entrance and add safety into Eagle Point from Highway 62.
