

Problem:

Oregon 99 is a major freight route. Its intersection with Pine Street is failing, particularly in the morning commute. This congestion and lack of a second rail crossing is hindering completion of an approved, master-planned Transit-Oriented Development (TOD).

Highway 99 in the vicinity of the new crossing does not have any bike or pedestrian facilities and some students are illegally crossing the railroad tracks and highway to gain access to Crater High School.



Project Scope:

The Twin Creeks Crossing is an urban at-grade rail crossing connecting vehicles, bicycles and pedestrian to Highway 99 and to Crater High School, as well as downtown Central Point.

RVTD is also planning to expand one of its routes once the crossing is built.
