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Northbound Winchester interchange ramps, Del Rio Road Bridge to close temporarily

WINCHESTER – The Del Rio Road Bridge spanning Interstate 5 and the northbound on- and off-ramps at the Winchester interchange (exit 129) are scheduled to be closed for several weeks starting Wednesday morning, October 12.


Drivers who need to reach the opposite side of the Winchester interchange are advised to use alternate routes.

All I-5 travel lanes and both southbound ramps at exit 129 will remain open.

Northbound I-5 motorists may use exit 127 (Edenbower) or exit 135 (Wilbur/Sutherlin).

The temporary closures will allow workers to realign Highway 99 on the east side of the Del Rio Road Bridge.

Construction on the \$22 million *I-5 Del Rio Road/Winchester Interchange* project will continue until September 2012. Motorists should expect congestion and intermittent delays at the Winchester interchange until the project is completed.
