

Transit Network Projects Recommended for Funding

The Oregon Department of Transportation is recommending 10 projects from around the state that enhance Oregon's statewide fixed route transit network. Funding comes from a variety of sources administered by the Rail and Public Transit Division (RPTD). The recommendations now go to the Public Transit Advisory Committee and the Oregon Transportation Commission for review and finalization.

In June of 2016, a committee composed of PTAC, RPTD, ODOT Planning Section, and ODOT Active Transportation Section representatives reviewed 12 applications. The total application request was \$996,647. The applications were evaluated, scored, and ranked for applicant eligibility, applicant management capacity, coordination with other partners, project value, and statewide transit network impact including how well the projects improved access to transit and connections between modes. Projects recommended for funding include a vehicle purchase, site improvements, a shared-use path, and electronic data solutions. The final total award recommendation is \$811,471.

Final awards will be announced following the Oregon Transportation Commission meeting on July 21, 2016. Grant agreements will be executed in August, 2016.
