

Oregon Medical Board
BOARD ACTION REPORT
April 15, 2012

Anderson, John Michael Jeremy, DO; DO26732; Hermiston, OR

On April 5, 2012, Licensee entered into a Corrective Action Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete courses on medical documentation and neuro-vascular assessment which have been pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

Dahms, Daphne Deborah, DO; DO156116; Seattle, WA

On April 5, 2012, Applicant entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Applicant agreed to submit a practice re-entry plan to include physician mentorship, and weekly meetings with her mentor for chart review and patient care issues. The plan and any changes to it must be pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

On April 6, 2012, the Board issued an Order Terminating Corrective Action Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's April 7, 2011, Corrective Action Agreement.

On April 5, 2012, the Board issued an Order Terminating Corrective Action Order. This Order terminates Licensee's August 3, 1998, Corrective Action Order.

***Guerreiro, John Palma, MD; MD26933; Beaverton, OR**

On April 6, 2012, the Board issued an Order Terminating Stipulated Order. This Order terminates Licensee's April 9, 2009, Stipulated Order.

***Haynie, Holland Hoyt, III, MD; MD26719; Burns, OR**

On April 5, 2012, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board for unprofessional or dishonorable conduct. This Order revokes the license (but the revocation is stayed), reprimands Licensee, places Licensee on probation for five years, assesses a fine of \$10,000, requires Licensee to complete a course on medical ethics and present a course on medical ethics, and requires Licensee to continue treatment with his healthcare providers.

On April 5, 2012, Licensee entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to have 30 percent of her radiological studies overread by radiologist(s) pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

***Powell, Diane Hennacy, MD; MD25438; Medford, OR**

On April 5, 2012, the Board issued an Order Terminating Stipulated Order. This Order terminates Licensee's January 13, 2011, Stipulated Order.

On April 5, 2012, Licensee entered into a Corrective Action Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete a pre-approved course on medical documentation.

On April 5, 2012, Licensee entered into a Corrective Action Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete a pre-approved course on professionalism in the health care setting, and continue his treatment with his healthcare providers.

1.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Holland Hoyt Haynie, III, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

The Board proposed taking disciplinary action pursuant to ORS 677.205 against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a).

3.

Licensee is a board certified family physician and was employed at the High Desert Medical Center in Burns, Oregon from 2006 until 2011. The acts and conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act are described below:

3.1 Patient A, an adult female, was employed at the High Desert Medical Center and worked directly for Licensee from late April to June of 2010 in delivering medical care to patients. Patient A also presented to Licensee as a patient at the High Desert Medical Center in 2010 with complaints of chronic back pain. Licensee provided medical care (with appropriate medical charting) to Patient A for back pain, had Patient A enter into a pain contract, and prescribed oxycodone & acetaminophen, 5/325 (Percocet, Schedule II) on February 17, 2010, May 27, 2010, June 24, 2010, August 20, 2010, and September 14, 2010,

1 5.1 The license of Licensee to practice medicine is revoked, but the revocation is
2 stayed.

3 5.2 Licensee is reprimanded

4 5.3 Licensee is placed on probation for five years. Licensee must report in person
5 to the Board at each of its quarterly meetings at the scheduled times for a probation interview,
6 unless otherwise directed by the Board's Compliance Officer or its Investigative Committee.
7 Licensee currently has an inactive Oregon medical license and resides in another state. The
8 requirement to appear for probationer interviews is held in abeyance as long as Licensee holds
9 an inactive Oregon medical license and does not live in Oregon.

10 5.4 Licensee must pay a fine of \$10,000. The fine is payable in full within 60 days
11 from the date this Order is signed by the Board Chair.

12 5.5 Within 180 days from the date this Order is signed by the Board Chair,
13 Licensee must enroll in and successfully complete a course in medical ethics and professional
14 boundaries that is pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

15 5.6 Within one year, Licensee must prepare a course on medical ethics and
16 professional boundaries that he must submit to the Board's Medical Director for approval, and
17 then must present to a group pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

18 5.7 Licensee must continue in ongoing mental health therapy and must sign all
19 necessary releases to allow direct communication between mental health care providers and
20 the Board's designee. Licensee will also ensure that his mental health care providers submit
21 quarterly reports to the Board regarding his mental health status, his level of insight in regard
22 to observing professional boundaries, and his ability to safely practice medicine.

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1 5.8 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order
2 would be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).
