On October 6, 2016, the Board issued an Order Terminating Stipulated Order. This Order terminates Licensee's April 3, 2014, Stipulated Order, and April 2, 2015 Order Modifying Stipulated Order.

This Order retires Licensee's medical license while under investigation.

On October 6, 2016, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board for unprofessional or dishonorable conduct; gross or repeated negligence in the practice of medicine; willfully violating any provision of the Board's statute, rule, board order or board request; and prescribing controlled substances without a legitimate medical purpose, or prescribing controlled substances without following accepted procedures for examination of patients, or prescribing controlled substances without following accepted procedures for record keeping. This Order reprimands Licensee; assesses a civil penalty of \$8,500; places Licensee on probation; requires Licensee to complete a CPEP education plan; requires Licensee to complete courses on medical documentation and prescribing; requires practice setting approval by the Board's Medical Director; subjects Licensee's practice to no-notice chart audits by the Board; requires Licensee to follow protocols when prescribing testosterone to male patients or antibiotics to any patient; and requires that Licensee only order lab tests which are supported in the medical record.

On September 21, 2016, the Board issued an Order Terminating Consent Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's July 28, 2016, Consent Agreement.

***Kuo, Wie-Peng, MD; MD27768; Medford, OR**

On October 6, 2016, Licensee entered into a Corrective Action Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to submit an educational plan to the Board's Medical Director for approval should she return to performing abdominal surgeries.

On October 6, 2016, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board for gross or repeated acts of negligence; and prescribing controlled substances without a legitimate medical purpose or without following accepted procedures for examination of patients or for record keeping. This Order reprimands Licensee; requires Licensee to complete a medical documentation course; requires Licensee to obtain a CPEP evaluation and complete any education plan recommended; prohibits Licensee from prescribing stimulants; places restrictions on Licensee's treatment of and prescribing for chronic pain; and places parameters on Licensee's prescribing for intermittent pain.

On October 6, 2016, the Board issued an Order Terminating Stipulated Order. This Order terminates Licensee's October 2, 2014, Stipulated Order.

On October 6, 2016, Licensee entered into a Corrective Action Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete pre-approved courses on medical oncology and medical documentation.

On October 6, 2016, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board for unprofessional or dishonorable conduct. With this Order, Licensee surrenders her acupuncture license while under investigation.



The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Malika Burman, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon and holds an active medical license.

The Board has opened an investigation into the conduct of Licensee in regard to her use of social media to respond to a former patient.

3.

In regard to the above-referenced matter, Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this agreement. Licensee understands that she has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes. Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this agreement in the Board's records. The Board agrees to close the current investigation and does not make a finding in regard to any violation of the Medical Practice Act. This agreement is a public document; however, it is not a disciplinary action. This document is reportable to the Federation of State Medical Boards.

4.

In order to address the concerns of the Board and for purposes of resolving this investigation, Licensee and the Board agree to the following terms:

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4.1 Within 180 days from the date the Board Chair signs this Agreement; Licensee must complete a course in professional boundaries (use of social media) that is pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

4.2 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon State laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of medicine.

4.3 Licensee agrees that any violation of the terms of this Agreement constitutes grounds to take disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

21 Order, Licensee may submit a written request to the Board to modify or terminate the
22 terms of probation.*

25 terminates terms 5.1, 5.2, and 5.3 of the July 10, 2014, Stipulated Order effective the date this
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1 Order is signed by the Board Chair. All other terms of July 10, 2014, Stipulated Order are
2 unchanged and remain in full force and effect.

Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds, that he engaged in conduct that violated ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a); and ORS 677.190(13) gross or repeated negligence. Licensee understands that this document is a public record and is

1 reportable to the National Databank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.



Licensee is a board certified internist practicing medicine in Bend, Oregon. The Board opened an investigation after receiving a report that in late 2015, while under investigation, Licensee resigned her medical privileges at her place of employment.

Licensee and the Board now desire to settle this matter by entry of this agreement. Licensee understands that she has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes. Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Agreement in the Board's records. The Board agrees to close the current investigation and does not make a finding in regard to any violation of the Medical Practice Act. This Agreement is a public document; however, it is not a disciplinary action. This document is reportable to the National Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

In order to address the concerns of the Board and for purposes of resolving this investigation, Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation contingent upon Licensee agreeing to the following conditions:

4.1 Within 120 days from the signing of this Agreement by the Board Chair, Licensee must successfully complete a course on prescribing that is pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

4.2 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon State laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of medicine.

4.3 Licensee agrees that any violation of the terms of this Agreement constitutes grounds to take disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

4.1 Licensee retires his license to practice medicine while under investigation. This retirement of license becomes effective the date the Board Chair signs this Order.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. James David Gallant, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

Licensee has an extensive record of discipline with the Board, which includes a Stipulated Order signed on October 2, 2014. The terms of this Order have not yet been completed. On July 22, 2016, the Board issued a Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action in which the Board proposed taking disciplinary action by imposing up to the maximum range of potential sanctions identified in ORS 677.205(2), to include the revocation of license, a \$10,000 fine, and assessment of costs, pursuant to ORS 677.205 against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a); and ORS 677.190(17) willfully violating a Board order.

Licensee and the Board agree to close this investigation with this Stipulated Order in which Licensee agrees to retire his license while under investigation, consistent with the terms of this Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes and fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the Board's records. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board

1 finds, that he engaged in conduct that violated ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or
