## ATV Safety Program Update (John Lane)

Oregon State University/4H has made considerable progress in the roll-out of their Oregon Safe Rider Evaluation Program

- Nearly a dozen Master Evaluators and Volunteers have signed on
- Cones Course is in phase II of trials with final work on Feb 5<sup>th</sup>
- Publications are near final draft
- Evaluator training in March
- Statewide rollout in June with between 41 and 47 evaluators
- In 2010 6,260 26,743 cards were issued to kids under 16 for a total of 72,882 Oregonians (2009/2010).
- - A total of 112,785 safety cards have been issued (40,000 out of state)

#### Grant Scoring

Staff recommends removing out a portion of the USFS NF John Day Grant, because that portion is development work. However, the can re-submit it at the April meeting. The O&M grant request would be \$580,484.63.

#### Scoring

Members discussed sharing scores with the applicants.

**Motion: Wade moved to recommend funding the year end grants that scored 60 and above. The motion was seconded by Pat. The motion passed unanimously.**

All year end requests, except Knappa FD were approved for recommendation. Knappa FD can re-apply in April 2011 but would be applying for funds from the 11-13 biennium, not as part of the year end funds. Staff will work with them to develop a new grant.

Members noted their concerns with USFS John Day grant due to the large increase from the past.

**Motion: Rod moved to recommend funding of the O&M grants that scored 70 and above. The motion was seconded by Steve. The motion passed unanimously.**

All O&M grant requests were recommended for approval.

**Motion: Pat moved to recommend funding of the Law Enforcement grants that scored 60 and above. The motion was seconded by Steve. Pat and Steve withdraw their motion.**

Members discussed their concerns about the statewide law enforcement program designed by Deschutes County Sheriff's Office. Members decided to remove the requested funds for the training program from the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office grant. Staff will work with them to develop the program.

**Motion: Rod moved to recommend funding of the Law Enforcement grants that scored 60 and above which includes the amended Deschutes County Grant. The motion was seconded by Steve. The motion passed unanimously.**

All law enforcement requests, except the Yamhill County Grant which ranked low due to the small amount of ATV riding areas they patrol, were recommended for approval. Staff will work with Yamhill County to assist them in revising their grant and re-applying at the April 2011 meeting.
