


Oregon Explorer Map Viewer
Guidance for Creating a Map for OWEB Grant Applications



1. Go to <http://oregonexplorer.info/> and click on 'Oregon Explorer Map Viewer' to open the tool.



2. Switch the Map Theme to 'Watershed Restoration'




3. Enter the town closest in proximity to your project in the search box (e.g., Salem).
a. Results will be listed in the left hand menu.
b. Click on 'Table View'
c. Select the 'Place Names' tab
d. Click on the name of the town once and the map will zoom to the location.

Note: the search box is in the upper right hand corner of the map viewer.



4. Using local knowledge of the landscape, use the pan tool at the top of the map, on the 'Explore Map' tab to locate the project location.




5. On the 'Create & Share' tab use the polygon markup tool at the top of the map to draw a project boundary.

Double click on the map once your shape is drawn to finish the sketch.



6. Mark the center of the project area with the latitude/longitude coordinate.
 - a. Click on the 'Analysis' tab
 - b. Select 'Plot Coords'
 - c. Click on the approximate center of the polygon you just drew.

Note: this coordinate can be used on the first page of the grant application.



7. To complete the map and create a PDF, click the **'Print Map'** icon on the **'Create & Share'** tab.



8. Title the map with the name of the project used on the application and click **'Create File'**.

Click **'Open File'** to open the PDF.

Note: keep the current default settings.
