The Hearing on Proposed Rule 710-005-015-0000 was held Tuesday, June 7, 2016 in Room 710 of Portland State University's College of Urban & Public Affairs, 506 S.W. Mill Street, Portland, OR.

For the record, the Notices of Proposed Rulemaking Hearing and corresponding Fiscal Impact Statements were published in the May 1st Edition of the Oregon Bulletin. Pursuant to ORS 183.335 the Notices were also sent to the appropriate Legislators. The Notices and Fiscal Impact Statements, along with the proposed rules, were also sent to all Interested Parties. Furthermore, the Notices and Fiscal Impact Statements, along with the proposed rules were posted on the Commission's public website. An advisory committee was not consulted because the process of developing the proposed rule was based on evaluations received from citizen panelists and moderators of past Citizens' Initiative Reviews as well as data from an external and independent research team.

Input on the proposed rule was sought through publication of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking Hearing in the Oregon Bulletin, and by furnishing copies of the notice to legislators specified in ORS 183.335, to the Commission's mailing list, and to the Associated Press and the Capitol Press Room.

The Hearing was convened, at 9:00 AM, by Sarah Giles, Administrative Coordinator and Presiding Hearing Officer. One Commissioner were present to hear any public comment.

Four members of the public appeared but did not present verbal or written testimony for or against the rule.

Given the absence of testimony, Ms. Giles recommended that the Commission pass the proposed rule as drafted at their next meeting at 10:30am on June 7, 2016.

Ms. Giles adjourned the Hearing at 10:30 AM.
