

Oregon Recidivism Analysis

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FOREWORD

In July 2013 the Oregon Legislature passed House Bill 3194, known as the Justice Reinvestment Act. Section 45 of HB 3194 (codified in ORS 423.557) redefined recidivism for Oregon to include the arrest, conviction, or incarceration for a new crime.¹ Since the passage of that legislation the Criminal Justice Commission (CJC) in coordination with our partners at the Department of Corrections, the Oregon Judicial Department, and the Oregon State Police have tracked and reported on this data.

This report looks at recidivism rates in new and different ways than previous reports in Oregon. We broke out recidivism rates by age, by gender, by race and ethnicity, crime type, and by level of risk to recidivate. We also looked at the amount of time that passed before recidivating events occurred. Some of the results conform closely to expected outcomes, but others may not. It is our hope that by looking at this information in different ways, people will be inspired to ask new questions, challenge existing beliefs, and help move Oregon forward to a safer future.

This report does not attempt to explain the underlying reasons for recidivism rates rising or falling in specific jurisdictions. The reasons for fluctuation are myriad, and those analyses are best done at a local level with the input of those who are intimately involved with the functioning of their local public safety systems. It is the goal of this report to give those public safety leaders the information they need to make informed decisions within their communities. The CJC is available as a resource to counties that would like to engage in a deeper analysis of their local public safety systems. In fact we have worked with and continue to work with multiple jurisdictions to analyze programs that are specifically targeting reduction of recidivism rates.

As always, we welcome feedback on our approach to this report, and we welcome new ideas for even more ways to understand this data.

Executive Summary

Historically, recidivism in Oregon has been tracked with a single definition: a new felony conviction within three years of release for incarceration or imposition of probation. Criminal justice stakeholders are well versed in this recidivism definition, and some are in the habit of referencing a single recidivism number from memory based on the latest recidivism analysis. The new definition essentially provides three measures of recidivism, and a richer context for recidivism analysis. Developing the analysis necessary to report recidivism using this new definition requires the merging of multiple criminal justice data systems on a scale never achieved before in Oregon.

This report is a follow-up to the first comprehensive statewide analysis² using the definition of adult recidivism in HB 3194 (codified in ORS 423.557). The most recent data available is included, along with additional analyses to disaggregate recidivism rates by age, gender, race, crime type, and risk to recidivate level.

Many factors can impact recidivism rates such as law enforcement resources and other criminal justice system resources, the risk profile of individuals in the system, changing emphasis on arrests or prosecutions, as well as the use of evidence based programs. This analysis does not attempt to explain why recidivism rates have changed over time, but simply displays the recidivism rates for offenders released from incarceration or sentenced to felony probation statewide and county by county.

This analysis shows the current statewide rates of recidivism:

For those released from prison or from a felony jail sentence in the first six months of 2012:

- 17% were re-incarcerated for a new felony crime within three years of release,
- 40% were convicted of a new misdemeanor or felony crime within three years of release, and
- 53% were arrested for a new crime within three years of release.

For those who started a felony probation sentence in the first six months of 2012:

- 12% were incarcerated for a new felony crime within three years,
- 39% were convicted of a new misdemeanor or felony crime within three years, and
- 46% were arrested for a new crime within three years.

Background

HB 3194 Section 45 (2013) (codified in ORS 423.557) provides a new statewide definition of recidivism. The definition includes the arrest, conviction, or incarceration for a new crime or for any reason. SB 366 (2015) removes the language that includes recidivating events that occur for any reason³.

The analysis in this report will focus on recidivating events for “new crimes”; it does not include recidivating events that occur for “any reason”. Recidivating events that occur for any reason include arrests or incarcerations for supervision revocations or sanctions.

Historically, the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC) and the Oregon Youth Authority (OYA) defined recidivism as a felony conviction within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation. The data sources available to DOC and OYA allowed for tracking this measure of recidivism. The agencies did not have access to the necessary data systems to track a broader definition of recidivism, which would require access to raw data from the Oregon Judicial Department and Oregon State Police.

For many years the Oregon Statistical Analysis Center (SAC), housed at the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), has had access to statewide data systems. The SAC serves as a clearing-house of criminal justice data, and has expanded its capacity in terms of data available and also in techniques to merge data across different systems.

The recidivism analysis in this report is a follow-up analysis to the first comprehensive statewide analysis using the definition of adult recidivism in HB 3194 (codified in ORS 423.557). Although there are limitations with the current available data, this analysis includes arrest, misdemeanor and felony conviction, and incarceration data in a single recidivism analysis.

Definitions and Limitations

Resource and technological limitations persist in Oregon, as they do in all states. Where we encountered data limitations we documented them in order to make this report as transparent and useful as possible. DOC tracks recidivism for offenders starting felony probation and for offenders starting post-prison supervision or parole supervision in six month cohorts⁴. This analysis uses these same cohorts as the starting population to track recidivism.

The CJC combined data from DOC with circuit court case data from the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), as well as arrest data from Oregon State Police (OSP) to track the three components of the new definition of recidivism in HB 3194 (codified in ORS 423.557).

This analysis provides historical information back to the first offender cohort in 1998 and is current through the first cohort of 2012. This provides historical data to track trends for the new definition of recidivism, and establishes a new baseline for future recidivism analysis. In the past a single definition of recidivism was tracked, which was a new felony conviction within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation.

As with past statewide recidivism analyses, this data does not include federal or out of state data. New criminal activity must be entered into electronic data systems in order to be captured as a recidivating event. If new criminal activity is

handled informally, and is not entered into an electronic data system, then it is not captured as a recidivating event in this analysis.

The three components (incarceration, conviction, arrest) of this new recidivism analysis are tracked separately. A single offender can contribute to all three measures, or a subset depending on the criminal justice system's response to the new criminal activity committed.

The Oregon Statistical Analysis Center does not have access to federal and out of state data, however the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) released an extensive recidivism analysis of 30 states in April 2014 that does include federal and out of state records⁵. BJS released a follow up analysis in September 2015 that analyzes out of state arrest rates⁶. This analysis shows that for prisoners released in Oregon in 2005, the percent increase in the in-state arrest rate when out of state arrests are included is 3.3% in 1 year, 4.9% in 3 years, and 5.3% in 5 years. The most common states where prisoners were arrested outside of Oregon were Washington, California, and Idaho.

Incarceration

Incarceration data is available from DOC and includes felony prison and felony jail sentences. The incarceration data includes felony incarceration sentences only and does not include misdemeanor jail sentences or jail time served pre-trial. Oregon does not have a statewide data system that provides misdemeanor jail sentence information by conviction or county, and therefore misdemeanor incarceration data at the statewide level is not available. The incarceration rate presented shows the percentage of each cohort incarcerated for a new crime within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation. Multiple incarceration events are not accounted for. The analysis captures whether an offender was or was not incarcerated within three years of release from prison or imposition of probation.

Conviction

Conviction data available from OJD includes data from the legacy Oregon Judicial Information Network (OJIN) and the new Odyssey case management systems. Oregon's 36 circuit courts are in the midst of a multi-year business transformation project converting from OJIN to Odyssey. At the time of this analysis there were 25 counties using Odyssey and 10 counties using OJIN; see the appendix for details.

This data includes misdemeanor and felony convictions from Oregon's 36 circuit courts. It does not include convictions from municipal courts or justice courts, as those courts are not part of the unified state court system. An extensive data merging process was done for entries in OJIN and Odyssey where the SID number is missing; see the appendix for details.

The conviction rate presented shows the percentage of each cohort convicted for a new misdemeanor or felony crime within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation. Multiple convictions are not accounted for. The analysis captures whether an offender was or was not convicted of a new crime (misdemeanor or felony) within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation.

Arrest

Arrest data is available from OSP's Law Enforcement Data System (LEDS). This data includes arrests where the person was finger-printed. It does not include arrests where the person was not finger-printed or other types of law enforcement contact not resulting in arrest. Fingerprinting is required in arrests for all felony crimes, and for misdemeanor drug and sex crimes. The arrest rate presented shows the percentage of each cohort arrested for a new crime within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation. Multiple arrests or multiple arrest

charges are not included. The analysis captures whether an offender was or was not arrested for a new crime within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation.

Statewide Recidivism Rates




Figure 1: Parole-PPS 3 Year Recidivism Rates

Figure 1 below shows the three recidivism measures for the parole and post-prison supervision (PPS) cohorts from 1998 to the first cohort of 2012. DOC defines cohorts of all individuals released to parole or PPS during a six month time period. In this 14 year time frame each recidivism measure shows a slightly declining overall trend from about 2000 and on. The incarceration rate varies from a low of about 13% in 1998 to a high of nearly 19% in 2004. For the first cohort of 2012 the incarceration rate was nearly 17%, which is an increase from the 2009 cohorts at 14%. The conviction rate varies from a low of nearly 37% in 2009 to a high of 46% in 1999. The conviction rate for the first cohort of 2012 was 40%. The arrest rate varies from a low of nearly 49% in 1998 and 2010 to a high of nearly 58% in 1999. The first cohort of 2012 shows an arrest rate of nearly 53%.




Figure 2: Probation 3 Year Recidivism Rates

Figure 2 below shows the three recidivism measures for the probation cohorts from 1998 to the first cohort of 2012. DOC defines the probation cohorts as comprising all individuals sentenced for the first time to felony probation during the six month period. Individuals sentenced to misdemeanor probation only are not included in the cohort. In this 14 year time frame the recidivism measures shows a declining overall trend from about 2005 to 2009, and then slightly increase from 2009 to 2012. The incarceration rate varies from a low of about 9% in 2009 to a high of 13% in 2005. For the first cohort of 2012 the incarceration rate was 12%. The conviction rate varies from a low of nearly 37% in 2008 to a high of 49% in 1998. The conviction rate for the first cohort of 2012 was 39%. The arrest rate varies from a low of nearly 42% in 2008 to a high of nearly 49% in 2005. The first cohort of 2012 shows an arrest rate of nearly 46%.

1, 2 and 3 Year Recidivism Rates




Figure 3: Parole-PPS 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Year

Figure 3 below displays the one, two, and three year recidivism measures for the first parole and post-prison supervision (PPS) cohort of 2012. The cumulative arrest measure increases from 35% one year after release to 53% three years after release. The cumulative conviction measure increases from 20% on year after release to 40% three years after release. The cumulative incarceration measures increases from 5% one year after release to 16% three years after release.




Figure 4: Parole-PPS Incarceration Recidivism Rates

Figure 4 below displays the one, two, and three year incarceration rates for the parole and post-prison supervision (PPS) cohorts from 1998 to the second cohort of 2013. The one year incarceration rate varies from nearly 5% to 7%, and is at nearly 6% for the second cohort of 2013. The cumulative two year incarceration rate varies from 9% to nearly 14%, and is at nearly 12% for the first cohort of 2013. The three year cumulative incarceration rate varies from 13% to nearly 19%, and is at nearly 17% for the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 5: Parole-PPS Conviction Recidivism Rates

Figure 5 below displays the one, two, and three year conviction rates for the parole and post-prison supervision (PPS) cohorts from 1998 to the second cohort of 2013. The one year conviction rate varies from nearly 17% to 24%, and is at nearly 22% for the second cohort of 2013. The two year cumulative conviction rate varies from 29% to nearly 38%, and is at 34% for the first cohort of 2013. The three year cumulative conviction rate varies from 37% to nearly 46%, and is at 40% for the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 6: Parole-PPS Arrest Recidivism Rates

Figure 6 below displays the one, two, and three year arrest rates for the parole and post-prison supervision (PPS) cohorts from 1998 to the second cohort of 2013. The one year arrest rate varies from 31% to nearly 39%, and is at 38% for the second cohort of 2013. The two year cumulative arrest rate varies from 43% to 51%, and is nearly 50% for the first cohort of 2013. The three year cumulative arrest rate varies from 49% to 58%, and is at nearly 53% for the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 7: Probation 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Year

Figure 7 below displays the one, two, and three year recidivism measures for the first probation cohort of 2012. The cumulative arrest measure increases from 30% one year after the start of probation to 46% three years after the start of probation. The cumulative conviction measure increases from 24% one year after the start of probation to 39% three years after the start of probation. The cumulative incarceration measures increases from 5% one year after the start of probation to 12% three years after the start of probation.




Figure 8: Probation Incarceration Recidivism Rates

Figure 8 below displays the one, two, and three year incarceration rates for the probation cohorts from 1998 through 2013. The one year incarceration rate has increased from 4% in the 2008 cohorts to 7% in the second cohort of 2013. The two year cumulative incarceration rate has increased from 7% for the first cohort of 2009 to nearly 10% for the first cohort of 2013. The three year cumulative incarceration rate has increased from 9% in the first cohort of 2009 to 12% for the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 9: Probation Conviction Recidivism Rates

Figure 9 below displays the one, two, and three year conviction rates for the probation cohorts from the first cohort of 1998 to the second cohort of 2013. The conviction rates have steadily dropped since the late 1990s. The one year conviction rate was nearly 37% for the first cohort of 1998 and has dropped to 29% for the second cohort of 2013. The two year cumulative conviction rate was 45% for the first cohort of 1998 and has dropped to 34% for the first cohort of 2013. The three year cumulative conviction was 50% for the first cohort of 1998 and has dropped to 39% for the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 10: Probation Arrest Recidivism Rates

Figure 10 below displays the one, two, and three year arrest rates for the probation cohorts from 1998 to the second cohort of 2013. The one year arrest rate has increased from 25% for the first cohort of 2008 to 35% for the second cohort of 2013. The two year cumulative arrest rate has increased from nearly 35% for the first cohort of 2008 to 42% for the first cohort of 2013. The three year cumulative arrest rate has increased from nearly 42% for the first cohort of 2008 to nearly 46% for the first cohort of 2012.

Length of Time to Recidivate




Figure 11: Parole PPS 1st Cohort 2012, Length of Time to Recidivate

Figure 11 below displays the length time to recidivate in months for the recidivism measures for the first parole-PPS cohort of 2012. The length time to recidivate is shown in months by the percentage of the cohort that recidivated. At 6 months after release, 23% of the cohort had an arrest for a new crime, nearly 11% had a conviction for a new misdemeanor or felony crime, and 2% were incarcerated for a new felony crime. After 9 months, 30% of those released have a new arrest. After 22 months 30% of those released have a new misdemeanor or felony conviction. After 21 months 10% of those released are incarcerated for a new felony.




Figure 12: Probation 1st Cohort 2012, Length of Time to Recidivate

Figure 12 below displays the length time to recidivate in months for the recidivism measures for the first probation cohort of 2012. The length time to recidivate is shown in months by the percentage of the cohort that recidivated. At 6 months after the start of probation, nearly 21% of the cohort had an arrest for a new crime, 15% had a conviction for a new misdemeanor or felony crime, and 2% were incarcerated for a new felony crime. After 13 months, 30% of those that started probation have a new arrest. After 19 months, 30% of those that started probation have a new misdemeanor or felony conviction. After 27 months 10% of those that started probation are incarcerated for a new felony.

Recidivism Rates by Risk to Recidivate Level

The figures below display the 3 year recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level. The risk to recidivate level is based on the Public Safety Checklist (PSC) score⁷. The PSC is a static, automated risk assessment tool that was developed to predict the likelihood of a new felony conviction within three years of release from incarceration or imposition of probation. The PSC uses criminal history and demographic data to calculate a risk to recidivate score. Community Corrections Departments in Oregon started using the PSC in 2012 as an initial triage tool and have decided upon cut-off scores to define low, medium, and high risk to recidivate populations. Low risk to recidivate is defined as a score less than 25%. Medium risk to recidivate is defined as a score greater than or equal to 25% and less than 42%. High risk to recidivate is defined as a score greater than or equal to 42%. Historical data has been used to calculate the PSC score for those released from incarceration or sentenced to probation for the cohorts from 1998 to 2013. The PSC was developed to predict a different recidivism measure from what is now the defined recidivism measure for Oregon. However the PSC risk to recidivate level still differentiates the population as shown in the graphs below.




Figure 13: Parole-PPS Cohorts Average PSC Score




Figure 14: Parole-PPS Cohort by Risk to Recidivate Level

Figures 13 and 14 below display the risk to recidivate profile of the parole-PPS cohorts. Figure 13 shows the average PSC score has dropped from 40% for the first cohort of 1999 to 36% for the second cohort of 2013.

Figure 14 below displays the number of those released from prison or local number for each cohort by risk to recidivate level. The low risk to recidivate population shows the largest growth proportionally, while the high risk to recidivate population has reduced proportionally to the total.




Figure 15: Parole-PPS Incarceration Recidivism Rates by Risk Level

Figure 15 below displays the 3 year incarceration recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level for the parole-PPS cohorts. The low risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year incarceration recidivism rate between 4% in 1998 and 9% in 2003. The medium risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year incarceration recidivism rate between 10% in 1998 and 18% in 2004. The high risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year incarceration recidivism rate between 23% in 2008 and nearly 31% in 2011. The PSC was developed to predict the recidivism measure of a reconviction of a felony with 3 years of release, but as shown below it also differentiates the population in predicting incarceration for a new felony within 3 years of release.




Figure 16: Parole-PPS 3 Year Conviction Recidivism Rates by Risk Level

Figure 16 below displays the 3 year conviction recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level for the parole-PPS cohorts. The low risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year conviction recidivism rate between 19% in 2011 and 27% in 1999. The medium risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year conviction recidivism rate between nearly 37% in 2002 and 43% in 2004. The high risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year conviction recidivism rate between 57% in 2007 and nearly 66% in 2000.




Figure 17: Parole-PPS 3 Year Arrest Recidivism Rates by Risk Level

Figure 17 below displays the 3 year arrest recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level for the parole-PPS cohorts. The low risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year arrest recidivism rate between 30% in 2002 and 37% in 2005. The medium risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year arrest recidivism rate between nearly 49% in 2002 and 57% in 2010. The high risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year arrest recidivism rate between 67% in 2008 and nearly 78% in 2012.




Figure 18: Probation Cohorts Average PSC Score




Figure 19: Probation Cohorts by Risk to Recidivate Level

Figures 18 and 19 below display the risk to recidivate profile of the probation cohorts. The average PSC score has been fairly consistent over time and ranges from nearly 24% to 26%.

Figure 19 below displays the number of those sentenced to probation for each cohort by risk to recidivate level. The proportion of low, medium, and high risk to recidivate has been consistent over time in the probation cohorts.




Figure 20: Probation 3 Year Incarceration Recidivism Rates by Risk Level

Figure 20 below displays the 3 year incarceration recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level for the probation cohorts. The low risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year incarceration recidivism rate between 6% in 1999 and nearly 9% in 2004. The medium risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year incarceration recidivism rate between 12% in 2009 and nearly 19% in 2005. The high risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year incarceration recidivism rate between nearly 21% in 2009 and nearly 34% in 2003. The high risk to recidivate population shows an increase in the incarceration rate from nearly 21% in the second cohort of 2009 to 29% in the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 21: Probation 3 Year Conviction Recidivism Rates by Risk Level

Figure 21 below displays the 3 year conviction recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level for the probation cohorts. All risk levels show a declining conviction rate over time. The low risk to recidivate population shows a drop in the 3 year conviction recidivism rate from 41% in the 1998 cohorts to 30% in the first cohort of 2012. The medium risk to recidivate population shows a drop in the 3 year conviction recidivism rate from 62% in the 1998 cohorts to 52% in the first cohort of 2012, though it has been increasing since reaching a low of 46% in 2008. The high risk to recidivate population shows a drop in the 3 year conviction recidivism rate from nearly 82% in the first cohort of 1998 to 68% in the first cohort of 2012.




Figure 22: Probation 3 Year Arrest Recidivism Rates by Risk Level

Figure 22 below displays the 3 year arrest recidivism rates by risk to recidivate level for the probation cohorts. The low risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year arrest recidivism rate between 39% in 2004 and nearly 34% in 2008. The medium risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year arrest recidivism rate between nearly 63% in 2000 and nearly 52% in 2008. The high risk to recidivate population shows a 3 year arrest recidivism rate between 82% in 1998 and 68% in 2008.

Recidivism Rates by Gender




Figure 23: Parole-PPS 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Gender

Figure 23 below displays the 3 year recidivism rates by gender for the first parole-PPS cohort of 2012. Females show a slightly higher recidivating arrest rate of 55% compared to males at 53%. Males show a higher recidivating conviction rate of 41% compared to 36% for females. Males also show a higher recidivating incarceration rate of 17% compared to 13% for females.




Figure 24: Probation 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Gender

Recidivism Rates by Age




Figure 25: Parole-PPS 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Age




Figure 26: Probation 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Age

Recidivism Rates by Race

The Hispanic population shows the lowest recidivism rates for arrest, conviction, and incarceration. African Americans, Caucasian, and other races (including Native American, Asian, and other races) all show a 56% arrest rate. African Americans shows the highest conviction rate at 54%, followed by Caucasians at 42%, and other races at 38%. African Americans shows the highest incarceration rate at 25%, followed by Caucasians at 17%, and other races at 13%.




Figure 27: Parole-PPS 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Race




Figure 28: Probation 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Race

Recidivism Rates by Crime Type




Figure 29: Parole-PPS Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Crime Type

Figure 29 below displays the 3 year recidivism rates by crime type for the first parole-PPS cohort of 2012. Those released from prison for a sex crime show the lowest recidivism rates for arrest, conviction, and incarceration, followed by those released for a person crime. Those released from prison for a drug crime show the highest arrest rate at 60%, followed by property crimes at 59%, and other crimes at 54%. Other crimes include weapon use, felony DUII, and failure to appear. Those released from prison for a drug crime show the highest conviction rate at 47%, followed by property crimes at 45%, and other crimes at 40%. Those released from prison for a property crime show the highest incarceration rate at 20%, followed by other crimes at 18%, and drug crimes at 17%.




Figure 30: Probation 1st Cohort 2012, Recidivism Rates by Crime Type

Figure 30 below displays the 3 year recidivism rates by crime type for the first probation cohort of 2012. Those sentenced to probation for a sex crime show the lowest recidivism rates for arrest, conviction, and incarceration, followed by those sentenced to probation for a person crime. Those sentenced to probation for a property crime show the highest arrest rate at 49%, followed by drug crimes at 47%, and other crimes at 45%. Other crimes include weapon use, felony DUII, and failure to appear. Those sentenced to probation for a property crime show the highest conviction rate at 45%, followed by drug crimes at 40%, and other crimes at 36%. Those sentenced to probation for a property crime show the highest incarceration rate at 15%, followed by other crimes at 12%, and drug crimes at 11%.

Appendix

Department of Corrections Cohorts

The Department of Corrections defines the Parole-PPS cohort as comprising all individuals released to parole or PPS during a six month period. It excludes those released from prison following a revocation from parole/PPS. Inmates initially released on temporary or transitional leave are also included as of their parole or PPS date.

The Department of Corrections defines the probation cohort as comprising all individuals sentenced for the first time in a custody cycle to felony probation during the six month period. Some offenders may have been sentenced to probation more than once. Each new probation admission is considered a separate case. The cohort does not include offenders sentenced to felony bench or court probation who are not supervised by a county community corrections department.

The cohort definitions are separated by county, to allow for county level analysis. To prevent a single individual from being included in multiple counties, DOC defines a county's release cohort as individuals under the county's supervision at the end of the three year period following release from incarceration. A county's probation cohorts are defined as offenders under the county's supervision at the end of the three year period following admission to probation.

Incarceration

The incarceration recidivism measure is compiled from the Department of Corrections data and includes prison sentences and felony local control sentences for a new crime. It typically does not include a jail sentence without any subsequent supervision, which is rarely used as a sentencing option for offenders. It does not include misdemeanor jail sentences, or jail time served pre-trial. Oregon does not have a statewide jail data system, and jail sentences in the circuit court case data are incomplete at the statewide level.

Conviction

The conviction recidivism measure is compiled from data collected from the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD) from both OJIN (Oregon Judicial Information Network) and Odyssey case management systems. These datasets provide misdemeanor and felony conviction data from Oregon's 36 circuit courts. For records where a SID (State Identification) number is missing, an extensive data merging process was followed to match records on name and date of birth; see the Data Merging Methodology section below.

The Oregon Judicial Department (OJD) transmits criminal case data using a secure file transfer to the Criminal Justice Commission (CJC) upon request. The CJC makes such a request of the OJD on approximately a quarterly basis. The data transmitted to the CJC includes information on:

- The defendant, such as the defendant's name, date of birth, address, demographic information (gender, race, etc.), driver license number, SID number, fingerprint and control number;
- The case event(s);
- The charge(s);
- Disposition of charge(s); and
- Sentence(s) imposed by the court.

This data is only from cases filed in circuit courts. The OJD sends data on all – not just new – cases every time data is sent to the CJC. OJD does not have access to information on cases filed in justice or municipal courts, as OJD does not have administrative control over those courts.

The OJD is currently in the middle of a significant information technology project – Oregon eCourt. Oregon eCourt involves an integrated system that includes electronic filing, case management, document access, and ePayment. As part of Oregon eCourt, circuit courts are transitioning from the Oregon Judicial Information Network (OJIN) to a new case management system, Odyssey. By June 2016, all circuit courts will have transitioned to Odyssey. Information provided to courts through OJIN utilizes a case number-based system. Under Oregon eCourt, all case information will be digitally organized by a person's name or names.

Arrest

Arrest data is available from the Law Enforcement Data System (LEDS) maintained by Oregon State Police (OSP). This includes arrests where the person was fingerprinted. It does not include arrests where the person was not fingerprinted or other types of law enforcement contact not resulting in arrest. Fingerprinting is required in arrests for all felony crimes, and for misdemeanor drug and sex crimes. Some law enforcement agencies fingerprint more arrests than are required, but the minimum should include the required crimes. OSP collects a bio-metric identifier, or fingerprint record, for all arrest records entered into LEDS. Unfortunately, arrest records are not separated into misdemeanor or felony crimes.

Data Merging Methodology

The majority of data merging across the different data systems used in the analysis was done using the SID number. The DOC data includes a SID number for all records. The LEDS data also includes a SID for all records, and is the source of the SID number creation by linking each SID with fingerprint records on file at OSP. The court case data needs a more complex data merging process due to missing SID numbers in the records. If the SID number was included in OJIN, then the same SID number matching was used. For entries where the SID number was missing, name and date of birth matching was used.

OJIN

At the time of analysis there were 10 counties using the OJIN data system. The OJIN counties were Baker, Clackamas, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Morrow, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, and Washington. The SID number in OJIN was missing for 24% of felony and misdemeanor conviction records. For these entries name and date of birth matching was used. Alias names and dates of birth were compiled, and these were used to match records where the SID number was missing. A test matching scenario was run on the 2010 cohorts. The name and date of birth matching using all aliases available resulted in 2.1% fewer matched entries than the SID number matching. This is likely due to name changes that are not entered as alias names, or data entry errors in the name and date of birth fields in OJIN.

Odyssey

At the time of analysis there were 26 counties using the Odyssey data system. The Odyssey counties were Benton, Clatsop, Columbia, Coos, Crook, Curry, Deschutes, Douglas, Gilliam, Hood River, Jackson, Jefferson, Josephine, Klamath, Lake, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Sherman, Tillamook, Wasco, Wheeler, and Yamhill. The Odyssey data extract that the CJC receives from OJD currently does not include the SID number. For Odyssey records matching was done on the first name, last name, and full date of birth. Alias names and dates of birth were compiled, and these were used to match the Odyssey records. A test matching scenario was run on the 2010 cohorts. The name and date of birth matching using all aliases available resulted in 2.1% fewer matched entries than the SID number matching. This is likely due to name changes that are not entered as alias names, or data entry errors in the name and date of birth fields in OJIN.
