Deer Ridge Correctional Institution inmate Clinton Swearingen II back in custody

An inmate who escaped May 4, 2014, from Deer Ridge Correctional Institution in Madras is now in custody in the Multnomah County Detention Center.

Law enforcement officials arrested Clinton Orvill Swearingen II on Friday evening at approximately 7:36 p.m., on charges of disorderly Conduct in the second degree, failure to obey a police officer, and resisting arrest in Multnomah County.

Swearingen entered DOC custody on Feb. 4, 2014, on one count of theft in the first degree, two counts of burglary in the second degree, and two counts of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle out of Linn County. His earliest release date is Dec. 10, 2017.
