High Alert Inmate

Criteria	Definition	Duration
Administrative Action	STM Intelligence	6 months
Arson/Explosive Device	1a – rule violation ORS 164.315, 164.325 + attempts	0-1 yrs.
Distribution	4e – rule violation	0-1 yrs.
High Risk Escapes	4h(A) – rule violation	0-5 yrs.
Hostage Taking	2m – rule violation	0-5 yrs.
Inmate Assaults	2a(C), 2b(A), 2a(D) – rule violations	0-2 yrs.
Inmate/Staff Relationships	4g – rule violation	0-5 yrs.
Interstate Transfer	Admitted from other state, fed	0-1 yrs.
Sexually Aggressive	STM intelligence based on incidents involving sexual assault and sexual coercion	0-2 yrs.
Staff Assaults	2a(A & B) – rule violation	0-5 yrs.
STG High Risk Behavior	4n – rule violation	0-1 yrs.
Weapons	4j(a) – rule violation	0-2 yrs.

STM Restriction Scale

1. If the restriction is solely based on managing the inmate and is not directly related to any other person, the restriction of service(s) shall fall within the following time frames:

First Restriction	1-7 days
Second or Third Restriction	7-14 days (STM Assistant Chief approval required)
Fourth and more	14-30 days (STM Assistant Chief approval required)

2. If the restriction is based on managing the inmate and is related to any other person, program, activity or behavioral plan, the restriction of service(s) shall fall within the following time frames:

First or Second Restriction	7-14 days (STM Assistant Chief approval required)
Third or Fourth Restriction	14-30 days (STM Assistant Chief approval required)
Fifth and more	30-60 days (SIU Assistant Chief approval required)

3. If the restriction is based on managing the inmate and is related to a potential threat to the safety, security and/or orderly operation of any Department of Corrections prison, institution, facility, program or activity, the restriction of service(s) shall fall within the following time frames:

First Restriction	30 days (STM Assistant Chief approval required)
Second or Third Restriction	30-45 days (SIU Assistant Chief approval required)
Fourth or Fifth Restriction	45-60 days (SIU Assistant Chief approval required)
Sixth and more	90 days (SIU Chief Investigator approval required)
Exigent circumstances	120 days (Inspector General approval required)
