Mental Health Co-Occurring Disorders

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
- More than 450,000 Americans with a recent history of mental illness are incarcerated in U.S. jails and prisons
- 24 percent are state prison inmates
- 21 percent are local jail inmates
- Of these, approximately 72 percent have a co-occurring substance abuse disorder
- By comparison, about 6 percent of the general population has a serious mental illness



Health Costs by Age

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
Offsite Health Care Per Inmate, Per biennium Costs 09/11 vs 11/13






Offsite Data and Costs Per Inmate

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

Percent of Total Population Requiring Special Health Care

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
