2. Review OAR 259-060-0060 (11)(a-c)-Minimum Standards for Training

The group discussed the definition of what “classroom”. The general consensus was that the firing range does include the meaning of “classroom”. The subcommittee has directed staff to developed draft OAR language that would clarify the training requirements to be reviewed at their next subcommittee meeting.

3. Review Curriculum

a. Armed Security Professional Training Manual

Chair, Donovan Beard opened the discussion to the members for any questions or concerns they have on the new refresher program. By general consensus the subcommittee members agreed that the refresher program looks great and no adjustments need to be made at this time.

4. Department Update

Mona Riesterer reported:

The PS-1 new certification/licensure application was just released along with the PS-21 renewal application to our constituents. The feedback from our constituents has been very positive.

Fieldprint, which is an electronic fingerprint capture service, is up and running smoothly. This is an additional option for our constituents to be able to use as well as the regular traditional ink fingerprinting and livescan

We have created a universal complaint process that will be used for all disciplines within DPSST’s jurisdiction. The website has been updated to explain DPSST’s jurisdiction and the complaint process.

William McKnight would like to discuss in the future the less than lethal force training as a part of a pre-requisite to Armed Certification in Oregon.
