

Board on Public Safety Standards and Training

1. Minutes of March 8, 2012

Approve minutes.

Jeff Martin moved to approve the minutes as written. Diana Simpson seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

2. OAR 259-008-0010, 259-013-0220, and 259-013-0230 – Proposed Rule

Minimum Standards for Employment as a Law Enforcement Officer, Individuals Subject to Criminal Records Checks, and Criminal Records Check Required

Linsay Hale reviewed the housekeeping changes.

Diana Simpson moved to approve filing the proposed language with the Secretary of State as a proposed rule and as a permanent rule if no comments are received. Jeff Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

By consensus, the committee determined there is no significant fiscal impact on small business.

3. OAR 259-008-0025 – Proposed Rule

Minimum Standards for Training

Linsay Hale reviewed the rule for the committee.

Diana Simpson moved to approve filing the proposed language with the Secretary of State as a temporary rule, a proposed rule, and a permanent rule if no comments are received. Jeff Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

4. Approval of Final Order

Requests approval of Final Order that differs from Proposed Order issued by Administrative Law Judge

Marilyn Lorange reviewed the background for the committee.

Diana Simpson moved to approve the change. Jeff Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

5. Director Update

- Director Gabliks reviewed the meeting with the Governor’s Buying Team last week. They had a lot of good questions and he was able to cover a lot of the issues in the hour allowed for DPSST.
- Rich Evans was approved as the Superintendent of Oregon State Police. He was also elected as the Chair of the Public Safety Memorial Fund Board which now has representatives from all the stakeholder groups.
- The Law Enforcement Contacts Committee (LECC), currently housed at Portland State University, asked DPSST for support while seeking funding. Director Gabliks requested approval to support their budget request during the legislative session. The Executive Committee was in support of the request, but it should not take precedence over DPSST funding needs. Director Gabliks agreed.
- Todd Anderson was selected as the finalist for the vacant Training Division Director position as is currently in the background process.
